



The report contains summary of activities related to forest protection within the JVA area such as conduct of regular foot patrolling, seedling production, forest tree nursery management and tree planting.



H I G H L I G H T S

Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) seeks to conserve the remaining forest through protection, reforestation of denuded areas, assisted natural regeneration (ANR) of the remaining forest, and secure the protection and maintenance of planted trees.

The Forest Protection project also aims to achieve the following:

- (1) Compliance with the JVA requirements;
- (2) Strengthening existing collaboration(s) with the MENRO, PCSD, DENR, Municipal LGU, and Local Government Units (LGU) of Ransang and Candawaga, Rizal and other local communities and partners primarily with the protection and reforestation of the denuded forest;
- (3) Supporting the National Greening Program of the Government (NGP);
- (4) Further enhancement of the awareness and capabilities of the local communities in the protection, and reforestation of denuded forests and establishment of endemic fruits & trees, and high-value fruit tree plantation;
- (5) Effective mobilization of local communities towards the protection of the remaining forest and establishment of high-value fruit tree plantation; and
- (6) help improve the living conditions of IPs and non-IPs through the promotion of raising indigenous tree and fruit tree seedlings.



For AUGUST 2023, the Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) has accomplished the following activities:

- A. Last August 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) Foot Patrol Unit regularly monitored illegal activities inside the Upland Agroforestry Adjacent areas. Based on the report made by the Foot Patrol Unit, the team roamed the site so far there are no illegal making activities monitored in the vicinity and neighbour of the Lionheart area. The presence of assigned LFPC Foot Patrol team, local Tribal Leaders and CENRO Staff resulting of the hesitation of illegalist to do the illegal activities inside the JVA and neighboring area. **(Please see photos attached as ANNEX A.)**
- B. Last August 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) nursery caretaker continued maintaining forest tree seedlings in the nursery through weeding, watering, application of fertilizer, and pest & diseases application. The total seedlings stock in the nursery is Nineteen thousand two hundred eighteen (19,218). **(Please see photos attached as ANNEX B.)**
- C. Last August 2023, Lionheart Farms (Philippines) Corporation (LFPC) planters team continue conducted of land preparation, alignment & sticking, holing, hauling of seedlings and planting. The LFPC planters team was out-planted of **One thousand eight hundred seventy-two (1,872)** *Swietenia macrophylla* seedlings



in Sitio Malutok, Ransang, Rizal, Palawan. (Please see


