

The activity was held on November 9, 2023 and participated by Barangay Officials, Barangay LGUs, MENRO, Bantay Dagat and DENR personnel. A total of 120 participants, 50 females and 70 males actively participated in the activity.

This activity focused on the adverse effects of oil spill to coastal and marine ecosystems. The importance of mangroves in coastal areas and the further effects on health of oil spill within the affected communities were also included in the IEC.

SUBJECT : **IEC ON OIL SPILL IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF PINAMALAYAN AND GLORIA, ORIENTAL MINDORO ON NOVEMBER 09, 2023**

The Phil-Star Global Manila Philippines released statement on June 17, 2023, that the Philippine Coast Guard announced the completion of the oil removal and recovery operation in Naujan, Oriental Mindoro, months after the unfortunate sinking of the MT Princess on February 2023.

In besides covering and harming marine animals, the spilled oil can disrupt food chains, contaminate water sources, and harm the environment over time. Cleanup efforts involve a combination of mechanical, chemical, and biological methods to minimize the impact and restore affected areas. Furthermore, the office notifies those affected that it has recovered from the oil spill, and people report that there is no longer any oil spill in our area. As a result, we are permitted to visit the sea and carry on with water activities like swimming and fishing.

The first municipality that this office have conducted IEC with regards to oil spill was Pinamalayan. One of the affected areas in Oriental Mindoro. That have Eight Barangay was affected namely barangay Banilad, Zone1, Quinabigan, Ranzo, Papandayan, Wawa, Lumangbayan and Brgy. Marfrancisco in Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro in this regard, this office has conducted an information education campaign to inform them of the value of being

prepared in case a similar situation arises again and its negative effects on our environment. Also, the effects of oil spills on human health. It was participated by Barangay Official, Bantay Dagat, MENRO, Barangay LGU, and DENR personnel.
