The PAMO-ENMRPA should also conduct a meeting/dialogue with the Punong Barangays to explore conservation projects that are aligned to the mandate of the DENR potential for funding under the IPAF consistent with the approved PAMP. Submit also a copy of attendance report during the orientation to validate if the various barangay seeking access on the IPAF are well represented.

Respectfully forwarded the memorandum report of Ms. Lucila G. Candeleja, Forest Technician II, pertaining the above subject.

Based on the submitted report, the activity conducted on October 3, 2023 is in response to the request of the *Liga ng mga Barangay* to utilize and access the fund for their projects under the Work and Financial Plan of IPAF for CY 2024. DENR Administrative Order 2021-13 or the Guidelines for the Development and recognition of BDFE in Protected Areas under National Integrated Protected Area System (NIPAS) and conservation areas, providing incentives and supporting mechanism and the result of Rapid Assessment and Inventory of accredited People's Organizations with enterprise operating inside and outside of ENMRPA and subjected for incentive and recognition under the BDFE were presented. The *Punong Barangays* were also informed about the process and permits needed to secure for the legality.

Some of the *Punong Barangays* proposed procurement of garbage collector, repair and maintaining of Material Recovery Facilities (MRF). They also proposed to have fund to be utilized for nursery projects and rehabilitation projects of watershed areas.

In view hereof, this office concurs with the recommendation to revalidate the existing accredited People's Organization of each barangay to update the 2022 data and consider other operating livelihood/enterprises potential for BDFE. The *Punong barangays* should explore other conservation projects aligned to the mandate of the DENR and potential for funding under IPAF.

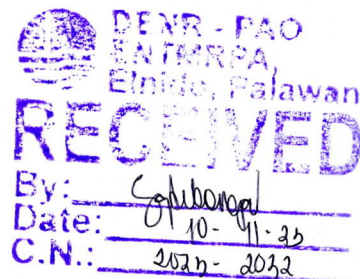

This pertains to the conducted orientation on biodiversity friendly enterprise (BDFE) and assistance provided among Protected Area Management Board of El Nido Managed Resource Protected Area (PAMB-ENMRPA) regarding the utilization of allocated fund per barangay under the Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) held on October 3, 2023 at Bgy. Corong-corong Hall, El Nido, Palawan. The activity was in response to the request of the *Liga ng mga Barangay* to utilize and access the fund under the Work and Financial Plan of IPAF for CY 2023.

Please be informed that the undersigned presented the DENR Administrative Order 2021-13 or the Guidelines for the Development and Recognition of BDFE in Protected Areas under National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) and conservation areas, providing for incentives and supporting mechanisms. The *Punong Barangays* were informed about the processes and permits that they need to secure prior to their operation and the legality/endorsement from the PAMB-ENMRPA. The undersigned also presented the result of the Rapid Assessment and Inventory of accredited People's Organization with enterprise operating inside and outside ENMRPA who can be potential for incentivization and recognition under the BDFE.

Meanwhile, *Punong Barangays* asked for a simplified process for them to utilize the fund because BDFE process will take too long, tedious and not doable within a year, accordingly. Most of the *Punong Barangays* are aiming to procure a garbage truck collector to address issue of solid waste management in the barangay while other barangays would like to have their current Material Recovery Facilities (MRF) to be repaired and maintained.

Some proposed to have the fund be utilized for their nursery projects and rehabilitation projects of watershed areas.

Assistant Protected Area Superintendent Jenuel P. Casel, who was also present in the meeting, said that the procurement of garbage truck collector was already deferred during last year's PAMB meeting in the presence of former RED Lormelyn Claudio because solid waste management is a mandate of the Local Government Unit and not by the DENR. APASu suggested passing a resolution from the *Liga of the Barangay* to the PAMB regarding this concern stating that the said procurement/projects are relevant to the on-going rehabilitation program of the municipality.

In view of the above, the undersigned recommends the following:

1. Revalidate the existing accredited People's Organization of each barangay to update the 2022 data and consider other operating livelihood/enterprises potential for BDFE;
2. *Punong Barangays* should also explore other conservation projects that are aligned to the mandate of the DENR and potential for funding under the IPAF.

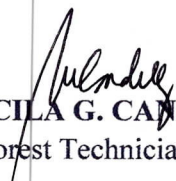
