2	Invite the Provincial Directors of DILG and Provincial Health Officers in MIMAROPA in the next RTF Meetings to be continuously updated of the current situation and relevant policies, and to provide the issues and concerns in the operationalization of the Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs) and clarify reasons why there still exist home quarantine of covid19 patients.	DILG MIMAROPA / DOH MIMAROPA
3	Reiterate the utilization of Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs) over home quarantine of COVID-19 positive individuals	DILG MIMAROPA
4	Reiterate the importance and benefits of vaccination against COVID-19, through intensified IEC Campaign, to dispel false information	DOH MIMAROPA / PIA MIMAROPA
5	Reiterate the recommendations of DOH MIMAROPA to the Local Task Groups COVID-19 of MIMAROPA, to continuously prevent the spread of COVID-19	OCD MIMAROPA
6	Provide OCD MIMAROPA with DOH Memorandum informing that COVID-19 vaccines may be administered to persons, including senior citizens, with mild hypertension (including the threshold of hypertension case) to be shared to all LTGs	DOH MIMAROPA
7	Invite OCD MIMAROPA to the table-top exercise to test the logistical deployment of COVID-19 commodities in the region, as indicated in the respective Surge Capacity Plans	DOH MIMAROPA
