SUBJECT : **INVITATION TO THE ONLINE WEBINAR SERIES ON
ECOTOURISM IN PROTECTED AREAS TOWARDS GREEN
RECOVERY**

The Biodiversity Management Bureau continues to support the Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) activities in protected areas through various learning events, capacity building and webinars. In line with this, the BMB in partnership with the UNDP's BioFin Project will be organizing a Webinar Series entitled, *Ecotourism in Protected Areas Towards Green Recovery*.

The three-part Webinar Series aims to discuss the effects of pandemic particularly on ecotourism in protected areas along with the recovery towards adapting to the new normal. Specifically, it aims to:

1. Inform the public on the impacts of the pandemic to the protected areas and the local communities and how everyone can build back better primarily through ecotourism;
2. Educate the public about the value of protected areas by showcasing local and international protected area managers and their respective ecotourism initiatives;
3. Increase awareness of Filipinos about policies related to protected areas and ecotourism, and their roles as responsible travelers and PA visitors;
4. Strengthen the capacities of protected area managers through sharing of good practices and new approaches/strategies that may be adapted by other PA managers; and
5. Encourage support for biodiversity conservation through ecotourism.

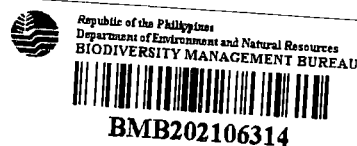
