

RESOLUTION REMINDING AND REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH), THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) AND THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) TO CONSULT THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN AS A CO-EQUAL BRANCH OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ORIENTAL MINDORO (PGOM) OF ALL UNDERTAKINGS OR ACTIVITIES INVOLVING SAND MINING AND LARGE-SCALE DREDGING WHETHER OR NOT IT INVOLVES RIVER REHABILITATION IN ORIENTAL MINDORO.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Oriental Mindoro believes that the DPWH, DENR and the DILG are fully cognizant that the local government refers to the structure of government under the LGC of 1991, consisting of the Local Chief Executive and the co-equal local legislative branch;

WHEREAS, all undertakings or activities involving sand mining and large-scale dredging in the Province of Oriental Mindoro warrant or requires consultation, review and/or prior approbation by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as the highest policy-making body of the Province is mandated to discharge its key role in decision-making in all aspect of the province's developmental undertakings, particularly those that have great impact on the lives of people and the province's environment;

WHEREAS, Section 2 (c) of the Local Government Code of 1991 expressly requires local government consultation prior to the implementation of any program or project in their jurisdictions:

"Section 2. Declaration of Policy. xxxxx

(c) It is likewise the policy of the State to require all national agencies and offices to conduct periodic consultations with appropriate local government units, nongovernmental and people's organizations, and other concerned sectors of the community before any project or program is implemented in their respective jurisdictions."

WHEREAS, Section 26(c) of the Local Government Code of 1991 reiterates the requirement of local government/consultation:

"Section 26. Duty of National Government Agencies in the Maintenance of Ecological Balance. - It shall be the duty of every national agency or government-owned or controlled corporation authorizing or involved in the planning and implementation of any project or program that may cause pollution, climatic change, depletion of non-renewable resources, loss of crop land, rangeland, or forest cover, and extinction of animal or plant species, to consult with the local government units, nongovernmental organizations, and other sectors concerned and explain the goals and objectives of the project or program, its impact upon the people and the community in terms of environmental or ecological balance, and the measures that will be undertaken to prevent or minimize the adverse effects thereof."

WHEREAS, Section 22 (c) of the Local Government Code of 1991 clearly states that prior authorization by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan is required of all local government contracts:

"Section 22. Corporate Powers. xxxxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall."

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Oriental Mindoro has not been consulted, much less has it reviewed, considered or approved any proposal, contract, agreement or project, or any notice to the public for the submission of letters of intent, by PGOM or any government agency, involving the River Restoration thru Large Scale Dredging of the Bongabong River, Bucayao River, Mag-asawang Tubig River, Balete River and Baco-Alag River or any river in the province, which is in the nature of a government infrastructure project subject to full compliance with R.A. No. 9184 and its Revised IRR, and all relevant environmental laws and ordinances;

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure that the disposition and utilization of Oriental Mindoro's natural resources and the implementation of public projects are only and truly pursued for the economic and ecological benefit of its people and future generations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOVED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, to remind and request Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Secretary Mark A. Villar, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Secretary Roy A. Cimatu, and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Secretary Eduardo Ano, and all concerned officials of the DPWH, DENR and DILG, to fully and properly consult the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as a co-equal branch of the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro (PGOM) on all initiatives, undertakings, activities or processes involving sand mining and large-scale dredging, whether or not it involves in full or in part river rehabilitation in Oriental Mindoro, to fully protect and promote public welfare and interest, and achieve transparency and accountability, in the implementation of government projects.

Let copies of this Resolution be furnished the Office of the President, the Executive Secretary, the Secretaries of DPWH, DENR, and DILG, Senior Deputy Speaker Salvador C. Leachon and Rep. Alfonso V. Umali, Jr., Provincial Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, all City and Municipal Mayors and all Sangguniang Panlungsod and Bayan in the Province of Oriental Mindoro, and all concerned government officials, including the Provincial Administrator, the Provincial Legal Officer and Provincial ENRO, for their information and/or appropriate action.
