Please be informed that there are no AUU fishponds turned over to this Office from 2014 up to present considering that as per attached letter response dated October 30, 2020 by DA-BFAR, Marinduque, there are no AUU fishponds under their jurisdiction. All fishponds areas within Marinduque are covered by Fishpond Lease Agreements (FLAs) while some with the Cancellation Order has a pending application for a twenty five-year lease contract.


Please provide the following information:

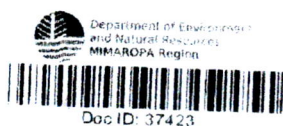

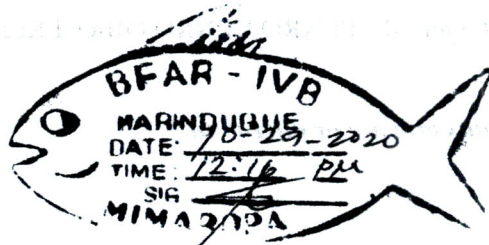
The said data will be used in the preparation of action plan for mangrove planting on abandoned and illegal fishponds within our area of jurisdiction.

Greetings!

This has reference to your letter received by this office on October 29, 2020, vis-à-vis your request for an electronic copy of the List/Inventory and Maps of all fishponds within the province particularly those idle fishponds that were turned-over and not yet turned-over by the bureau to your office.

We would like to inform you that the fishpond areas under the jurisdiction of this bureau are those that are covered by the Fishpond Lease Agreement (FLA). For which reason, our bureau did not turned-over any fishpond areas under our jurisdiction to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR). Because all FLA areas still under the jurisdiction of the Department of Agriculture-Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (DA-BFAR) are all operational while some with the Cancellation Order has a pending application for a twenty-five-year lease agreement.

Relative thereto, we regret to inform you that this office has no areas to recommend for your mangrove planting/rehabilitation program.
