This pertains to your Memorandum dated 16 July 2021 which was received by this Office on 27 July 2021 submitting the consolidated report on the maintenance of the Individual Plus Trees (IPTs) and clonal nursery located within the administrative jurisdiction of MIMAROPA Region.

Please be informed that we have noted a total of 3,210 IPTs maintained within the region excluding PENRO Romblon which have not yet submitted a report. We also noted that MIMAROPA Region had already collected a total of 20.05kg or 10,645 seeds of different species. Further, the clonal nursery managed by PENRO Oriental Mindoro has already produced 2,129 quality planting materials or 21.29% of the total target production.

In this regard, may we request the region to strictly follow the prescribed templates indicated in the memorandum of Usec. Sampulna dated 15 January 2021 for clonal nurseries and memorandum of Usec. Cuna dated 26 September 2019 for the seed collection reports from the Seed Production Areas (SPAs) and Individual Plus Trees (IPTs) to facilitate consolidation of the reports.

Attached herewith are memorandum dated 15 January 2021 signed by Usec. Sampulna, memoranda dated 26 September 2019 and dated 12 March 2018 both signed by Usec. Cuna for your reference and perusal.

We are submitting the consolidated report of NGP MIMAROPA, physical and financial performance, on the maintenance of Individual Plus Trees and Production of Quality Planting Materials for your information, reference and record.

Individual Plus Trees (IPTs) Maintained

The MIMAROPA Region has maintained **3,210** Individual Plus Trees of the following forest tree species Narra, Gmelina, Mahogany, Auri, Ipil, Alalud, and Dita. Not included in the report yet is the number of IPTs maintained by PENRO Romblon. This Office is yet to receive their report.

Maintaining IPTs involves the conduct of the following silvicultural treatments to enhance seed production, facilitate seed collection, and protect the IPTs against biotic and abiotic agents: removal of undesirable vegetation up to five meters beyond tree periphery; and removal of trees of similar species with poor stand/quality that will promote inbreeding.

The concerned PENRO staff adequately observe, document, and report the physiological developments or physical stage of every maintained IPTs using the Phenology Calendar submitted monthly.

Seeds Collected

The PENROs of Oriental Mindoro and Palawan collected seeds of Mahogany, Alalud, Lamio, and Nato with a total volume of **20.05** kilograms with a 10,645 seed count, as shown in the attached table. However, according to the phenology calendar, the PENROs of Marinduque, Occidental Mindoro, and Romblon have no seed collection yet as their IPTs are not bearing fruits yet.

The PENROs use the collected seeds to produce their seedlings. From their collections, they have grown **2,060** seedlings.

IPTS Maintenance Financial Performance

For the status of financial performance, PENRO Marinduque obligated an amount of **Php 233,490.00** (58.37%) and disbursed **Php 195,380.00** (83.68%). Likewise, PENRO Oriental Mindoro obligated an amount of **Php 344,830.00** (86.20%) and disbursed a total amount

of **Php 131,330.00** (35.19%). PENRO Palawan obligated **Php 100,000.00** (25%) of the allotment and disbursed **Php 66,593.62** (66.59%). PENRO Occidental Mindoro obligated **Php 187,257.14** (46.81%) and disbursed **Php 149,287.14**. PENRO Romblon obligated **Php 139,727.10** (34.93%) and disbursed **Php 39,960.00**.

In sum, the total amount obligated was **Php 1,105,302.84**, while the total amount disbursed was **Php 668,023.36.00**.

Quality Planting Materials Produced

As of the 2nd quarter, PENRO Oriental Mindoro has produced 2,129 quality planting materials or 21.29% of the total target production.
