## PRIVATE LAND TIMBER PERMIT PLTP No. RIVB - 23/- 202/

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, DAO No. 2000-21 "Revised Guidelines in The Issuance of Private Land Timber Permit/Special Private Land Timber Permit (PLTP/SPLTP)" and DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-07 dated May 19, 2016 regarding the "DENR Manual of Authorities on Technical Matters", and to the existing Forestry laws, rules and regulations, is hereby granted to:

## MS. MA. SOFIA O. OLANO

a citizen of the Philippines with residence address located in Barangay San Roque, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.

This PERMIT is subject to pertinent Forestry laws, rules, and regulations, and including the terms and conditions set forth in the DENR Administrative Order No. 2000-21 dated February 28, 2000, and the following conditions shall be observed to wit:

1. Only the inventoried/inspected one (1) naturally-grown Dita (*Alstonia scholaris*) tree within a titled property covered by TCT No. (T-16307) 063-2020000652 located in Brgy. San Roque, San Jose, Occidental Mindoro, with a net harvestable volume of **3.94 cu. m.** shall be cut, as shown in the table below:

- 2. The logs and derivable wood materials to be recovered from the cut tree belong to the permittee subject to payment of forest charges. The forest charges shall be based on the result of scaling after cutting operation. Provided, that in case of transport, necessary transport documents shall be secured from the local DENR Field Office concerned;
- 3. Prior to the tree cutting operation, a placard or signboard with a dimension of 4 feet by 8 feet shall be installed in a conspicuous place to inform the public that the tree cutting operation is authorized by the DENR.
- 4. The permittee shall replace the tree cut with one hundred (100) seedlings strictly of indigenous species in compliance with the DENR Memorandum Order No. 2012-02 dated November 05, 2012 re: "Uniform Replacement for Cut and Relocated Trees" to be turned-over to the local DENR Field Office concerned in support to the National Greening Program (NGP) and climate change initiatives of the Government;
- 5. The tree cutting operation shall be at all times under the direct supervision of the Regional Executive Director concerned or his duly authorized representatives. The Regional

Executive Director shall be held administratively, civilly, and criminally liable should this Permit be used in any illegal purpose;

- 6. The chainsaw to be used in the cutting operation shall be registered pursuant to DAO 2003-24 entitled "Implementing Rules and Regulation of the Chainsaw Act of 2002;
- 7. The permittee shall be required to undertake necessary measures during and after cutting operation to mitigate the negative impacts of the said activity to the locality; and
- 8. Violation of any of the above conditions shall be sufficient ground for termination/cancellation of the permit, subject to due process without prejudice to the imposition of appropriate penalties pursuant to existing regulations.

This PERMIT is effective on the date of issuance and expires FIFTY (50) DAYS upon receipt of the Permittee or as soon as the volume authorized herein is exhausted, whichever comes first.
