SUBJECT : CANCELLATION OF LAND TRAVEL FROM LUZON BOUND TO MINDANAO

DATE : 23 December 2021

1. Reference: RDRRMC VIII Memorandum dated December 22, 2021.
2. The seaport terminal in the Municipality of Liloan, Southern Leyte is currently congested due to lack of shipping and increasing number of stranded passengers and vehicles bound for Mindanao. Likewise, the San Ricardo Port is currently non-operational due to the damaged caused by Super Typhoon Odette.
3. The Regional Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council VIII will temporarily suspend land travel from Luzon bound to Mindanao through any point in Eastern Visayas effective 12:00NN 22 December 2021 until further notice except for those transporting relief and other essential perishable items.
4. This proactive measure aims to prevent further build-up of passengers and vehicles at the Liloan seaport which was also hit by onslaught of Super Typhoon Odette
