The Asian Institute of Management TeaM Energy Center for Bridging Leadership (AIMTEC-BL) will be conducting the online leg of the **Bridging Leaders' Initiative for Climate Resilience (BLICR)** hybrid workshop for Cagayancillo, Palawan entitled: **Building Multistakeholder Ecosystem-based Adaptation (EbA) Solutions for Cagayancillo's Marine Protected Areas (MPA).**

The online workshop will be held on December 9, 10, 13, and 20 from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM

This workshop, beginning on **December 9**, will showcase the Implementation and Management of MPAs project of **Mayor Sergio Tapalla** and Ms. **Maria Pamela Castro** of Pilipinas Shell Foundation, Inc., fellows of the BLICR program. Their EbA project was incubated through the program and is currently being developed and implemented in Del Carmen.

Continuing the session will be **Ms. Kring Luardo** of the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) to discuss financing programs offered by the DBP, which local governments and their private sector partners can utilize to finance their EbA projects.

The last part of December 9 will be the introduction of Bridging Leadership and its core processes of Ownership, Co-Ownership, and Co-Creation as it relates to the sustainable development of Cagayanillo and its MPAs. **Prof. Manuel De Vera**, Executive Director of the AIM TeaM Energy Center for Bridging Leadership (AIMTEC-BL) will facilitate this session.

For **December 10**, participants will be introduced to the concept of Design Thinking through the lens of developing, implementing, and sustaining Ecosystem-based Adaptation solutions for Cagayancillo's natural resources. By adapting the Business Model Canvas to this perspective, participants will be able to utilize this practical tool for the protection and preservation of the environment. The discussions and workshops will be facilitated by **Prof. Richard Cruz**, Associate Professor at AIM.

December 13 will be facilitated by **Dr. Timothy Ting,** adjunct faculty at AIM. He will facilitate structured learning exercises in Transformative Scenario Planning, which will challenge the participants to envision the future of Cagayancillo and determine ways to conserve and protect the natural assets of the municipality.

On **December 20**, there will be a last session with **Mr. Michael Rellosa**, of the Philippines Insurers and Reinsurers Association. He will introduce the role that the insurance industry plays in protecting and managing MPAs through various insurance schemes in the Philippines right now.
