Forwarded are the requests from representatives of Barangay Paitan and Metolza, Naujan Oriental Mindoro requesting for the relocation of boundaries of lot covered by Proclamation No. 809 issued on June 4, 1935 (Paitan Mangyan Reservation).

Be informed that a meeting/dialogue was held at PENRO Conference Room on March 5, 2020. The meeting was organized to discuss the issues and concerns arising between Barangay Metolza leaders/farmers and Mangyan Tribe leaders/residents of Barangay Paitan, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro regarding boundary conflict on Paitan Mangyan Reservation. The two groups agreed for a relocation survey to exactly locate the actual boundaries of Paitan Mangyan Reservation.

Further, there are cases relative to Paitan Mangyan Reservation that are pending before the Supreme Court. Hence, a request for legal opinion is requested.

MINUTES OF MEETING CONSULTATIVE MEETING/DIALOGUE REGARDING MANGYAN RESERVATION PAITAN NAUJAN ORIENTAL MINDORO

HELD AT PENRO CONFERENCE ROOM, BRGY. SUQUI, CALAPAN CITY, ORIENTAL MINDORO MARCH 05, 2020

The meeting started at 9:00 in the morning Thursday March 05, 2020. It was opened through a prayer, followed by acknowledgement of attendees facilitated by Ms. Maria Alva Renelyn A. Culla-Umali Chief, Regulation and Permitting Section (RPS). Atty. Mark N. Marcos, Municipal Mayor of Naujan, Oriental Mindoro delivered the message citing that the proposed fencing of boundary of Paitan Mangyan Reservation was due to Local Government Memorandum Order to Local Chief Executive to conduct road clearing on their respective jurisdiction. The Mayor noted that Barangay Metolza and Paitan Leaders were not aware of the reservation boundaries. Miss Culla-Umali gave the backgrounder of the Paitan Mangyan Reservation and status of cases relative to the contested area. She also explained/discussed and defined the technical terms use in the case including DENR Administrative Order No. 73 which provide for the delineation, identification and compensation relative to the Mangyan Reservation. NCIP Director for MIMAROPA Roberto Almonte CESO III gave an additional backgrounder of the Paitan Mangyan Reservation for information and references of the attending parties. Director Almonte explained that Non-Mangyan claimants were already paid-up except for those who refused on the offered appraised amount. He further stressed that under negotiation the claims of Non-Mangyans were already appraised prior to April 30, 1995 deadline, however payments were not effected due to non-acceptance and or refusal of some claimants/applicants.

According to Atty. Marcos this meeting was called to order to address the issues and concerns arising between Barangay Metolza leaders/farmers and the Mangyan tribe leaders/residents of Barangay Paitan, regarding boundary conflict on Mangyan reservation. The two (2) groups agreed for a relocation survey to exactly locate the actual boundaries of the Proclamation No. 809 dated June 04, 1935 known as Paitan Mangyan Reservation.

Atty. Marcos explained to the groups that relocation survey needs financial assistance to support the said survey and one strategy that transpired during the meeting is to request from DENR for the conduct of relocation survey.

Atty. Marços and Director Almonte agreed that DENR will secure legal opinion to the Office of Solicitor General (OSG) which represent the Republic of the Philippines as state legal counsel relative to the conduct of relocation survey since the case of Paitan Mangyan Reservation was already elevated in the Supreme Court for proper and final disposition. Forester Esperanza Cortez, OIC-Technical Services Division Chief of PENRO Oriental Mindoro stated that the legal opinion is necessary to ensure the conduct of relocation survey will not affect nor influence the on-going court proceeding in the highest court of the country, yet relocation survey will be executed smoothly if ever OSG will give permission on the survey.

The Metolza Officers and farmers together with the Mangyan Tribe leaders of Barangay Paitan agreed that they will respect whatever the outcome and the result of relocation survey on the ground based on Approved Technical Description of Paitan Mangyan Reservation.


The meeting ended at around 11:00 in the morning wherein attendees are praying to resolve the case as early as possible.






The participants during the Invocation











