Other Observations:

As per inspection, the construction FMR and bridge project of the Provincial LGU of Palawan still hasn't started. But it is to be noted that, the Provincial LGU of Palawan is on the process of securing the Certificate of No Objection from the DENR which is needed before the actual start of the project.

As per PEMU Palawan Database, the Provincial LGU has no SMR and CMR submission for the said project. Further verification is needed to check the compliance of the proponent to this condition.

Remarks and Recommendations:

Before the actual start of the construction, the Provincial LGU should ensure to designate an accredited PCO for the project and should comply the necessary reports such as the SMR and CMR. Further, the Provincial LGU should enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the concerned DENR-Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office in the implementation of the tree planting activity within thirty (30) days prior to project implementation. The tree planting is one of the recommended activities in compliance with the government's commitment to the Kyoto Protocol Agreement.

Recommended for issuance of Certificate of No Objection.
