- Solve this problem at the Regional Level. Regional Level Clusters should go first to CORDS before to the NTF-ELCAC.

- Add assessment of Organization in the perspective of Organizational Development (DILG-Lead Clusters).

- Site the specific barangay where the PPA was implemented. 25 Barangays refer to SBDP Barangays. 54 Barangays are prioritized for the conduct of RCSP.
