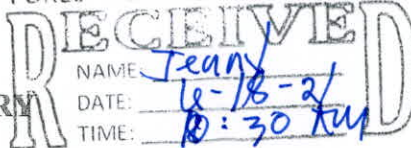

Respectfully submitted is the apprehension report on illegal logging, wildlife and cases filed as of May 31, 2021.

Please be informed that as of May 2021, there were a total of 108 apprehensions made in the entire region with most of the reports came from the province of Occidental Mindoro with a total of fifty seven (57), in which half of the total number of apprehensions were assisted/initiated by the PNP/AFP.

Said apprehensions had a total estimated fair market value of **Php2,352,005.27** for the forest products alone excluding the market value of the apprehended units of chainsaw and conveyances. A total of 19 units of chainsaw were apprehended from the provinces of Oriental and Occidental Mindoro, and Palawan. Also, there were four (4) reports of less than 10 sacks of undocumented wood charcoal apprehended in the region.

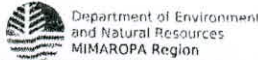
