We acknowledged receipt of downloaded fund from Regional Office with SAA NO. 2021-06-044 dated June 9, 2021 amounting to Php84,500.00 for the Purchase of Pneumonia vaccines for 65 officials and employees as part of Health and Wellness Program as per Approved FY 2021 Work and Financial Plan of the Region.

However, after canvass of the unit price was done, the lowest cost per vaccine that we get is Php2,500.00 for Anti-Pneumonia and Php1,500.00 for Anti-Influenza.


The total budgetary requirements for the 2 types of vaccine is amounting to One Hundred Forty Eight Thousand pesos (Php148,000.00) for 62 vials -- PhP137,500.00 for 55 Anti-Pneumonia; and Php10,500.00 for 7 Anti-Influenza. This computation is based on the actual number of permanent personnel willing to be vaccinated (please see attached list).

In view hereof, we would like to request for downloading of additional fund to augment the budget deficit of the above vaccines in the total amount of **Sixty Three Thousand Five Hundred pesos (Php63,500.00).**
