STRATEGY AND ACTION PLAN-PHILIPPINES: 2020-2030 AS THE
NATIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF
INVASIVE ALIEN SPECIES IN THE COUNTRY"*

In view of the joint initiative of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and the Department of Agriculture to address the problem on invasive alien species (IAS) in the country, transmitted herewith, is a copy of the DENR-DA Administrative Order No. 2020-02, *"Adopting the National Invasive Species Strategy and Action Plan-Philippines: 2020-2030 as the National Framework for the Management of Invasive Alien Species in the Country."*

The NISSAP is a framework for a coordinated and multi-sectoral approach to prevent further introduction of IAS in the country, control or eradicate ongoing invasions, and restore ecosystems damaged by these species. It is a 10-year plan developed after an extensive research on IAS in the Philippines, hand in hand with a democratic consultative process. Moreover, the NISSAP is consistent with and complementary to the goals of the Philippine Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (PBSAP) which serves as the roadmap for the conservation and management of the country's biodiversity.

Relative to its adoption, the DENR Regional Offices are advised to integrate measures for the effective control and management of IAS in their respective work plans in compliance with the provisions of the NISSAP.
