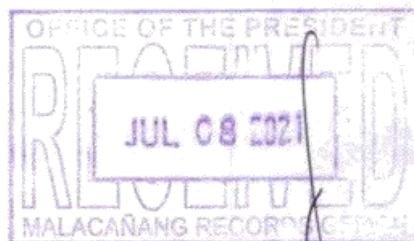

Dear Mr. President:

The Rizal, Occidental Mindoro's 21-kilometer arterial river is now being de-silted and widened to minimize if not totally prevent flooding of low lying barangays, and to give way to other projects that will give additional income to poor farmers and fisherfolk. This phase of the project is being undertaken by the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH).

The second phase of the project will be the massive planting of bamboos along the river bank of the waterways to hold back the scooped out earth from going back to the river (the third phase of the project is the setting up of aquaculture enterprise in the waterways, while the fourth phase is putting into effect tourism-related activities). The project requires 21,000 pcs. of giant bamboo seedlings and 21,000 Tonkin bamboo seedlings planted on both sides of the river bank.

The giant bamboos, after reaching their maturity age, will be used in the production of engineered bamboos, while the Tonkin bamboo (or any bamboo species comparable with the strength of Tonkin) will be used in the manufacture of bamboo bikes. The municipal government of Rizal will partner with TESDA and DOST in these undertakings.

Thus, we are writing to seek your help, through the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), for the obtainment of bamboo seedlings and for the successful implementation of our bamboo planting project which we believe is a great game-changer for the people of Rizal, Occidental Mindoro.
