




SC RULING ON THE MANDANAS – GARCIA PETITIONS

The Supreme Court (SC) has ruled with finality that the just share of LGUs from the national taxes is not limited to "national internal revenue taxes" collected by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) but includes collections (customs duties) by the Bureau of Customs (BOC).

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 138

FULL DEVOLUTION OF CERTAIN FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, CREATION OF A COMMITTEE ON DEVOLUTION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Section 6, Article X of the Constitution provides that local government units (LGUs) shall have a just share, as determined by law, in the national taxes which shall be automatically released to them;

WHEREAS, in Mandanas, et al. v. Executive Secretary, et al. (G.R. Nos. 199802 and 20468) ("Mandanas"), the Supreme Court held that all collections of national taxes, except those accruing to special purpose funds and special allotments for the utilization and development of the national wealth, should be included in the computation of the base of the just share of LGUs;

WHEREAS, considering the prospective character of the Mandanas ruling, and in keeping with Section 284 of Republic Act (RA) No. 7160 or the "Local Government Code of 1991," which states that the share of LGUs in national taxes is based on the collections in the third year preceding the current fiscal year, the adjusted national tax allocations of LGUs shall only start in Fiscal Year (Fy) 2022;

WHEREAS, given the revenue collections of the National Government in FY 2019, the total shares of the LGUs from the national taxes is expected to significantly increase starting FY 2022 in line with the implementation of the Mandanas ruling:

WHEREAS, the substantial increase in the shares of the LGUs from the national taxes will empower the LGUs in providing basic services and facilities to their constituents, and aid of RA No. 7160:

WHEREAS, Section 3 of RA No. 7160 provides the operative principles of decentralization that shall guide the formulation of policies and measures on local autonomy;

WHEREAS, Section 17(f) of RA No. 7160 provides that the National Government or the next higher level of LGU may provide or augment the basic services and facilities assigned to a lower level of LGU when such services or facilities are not made available or, if made available, are inadequate to meet the requirements of its inhabitants;

INTERVENTION FOR LGUS

RATIONALE

Improved local governance is essential for the accountable, transparent, and effective delivery of public services at the local level. Since the enactment of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Government Units (LGUs) have been at the forefront of delivering basic services and supporting the attainment of national development agenda. Recently, the Supreme Court's decision on the Mandanas-Garcia petition mandates the full devolution of functions and services stipulated in Section 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991 to the LGUs. With this, they must strengthen their capacities and adopt a more holistic approach to local governance and public administration.

With the imminent demand for service delivery, the LGUs have to undertake Capacity Development (CapDev) interventions to be able to take on fully-devolved services and ensure the achievement of development goals and objectives. Limitations in resources of both LGUs and government service providers, however, necessitate a mechanism or system that will harmonize the provision of CapDev for LGUs. However, there are varied interpretations of CapDev in the local government sector. Mostly, it is limited to competency interventions such as training and seminars. Hence, this framework establishes a multifaceted concept of CapDev that addresses both the individual and organizational concerns of LGUs.

CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT

Process by which individual competencies and institutional capacities are enhanced through strategic and integrated interventions to equip and empower LGUs to fulfill their accountabilities and produce desired results



CAPACITY

Ability of LGUs to perform functions to fulfill their accountabilities and produce desired results





PERFORMANCE

Effectiveness of the LGU in doing its **mission** or what its **mandate** says, and producing desired **results**

- How do we scope and sequence interventions?






LGU CAPDEV CYCLE


The Online CapDev Market System (OCDMS) is a one stop website showcasing the **DEMAND** and **SUPPLY** side of the CapDev.
