Please be informed that on July 07, 2021 at around 12:47 PM, our concerned technical personnel, (Forest Technician I, John Andrew Magculang and Forest Ranger Jonathan Telan), confirmed on the ground a report in PENRO Facebook Page by a concerned citizen, the alleged illegal cutting of Acasia trees in Barangay Tampus, Boac, Marinduque.

Based on their findings, they have detected along Boac river in the said barangay two (2) freshly cut Acasia trees wherein trunks and branches were cut into six (6) pieces of logs, consisting a total volume of 8.13 cubic meters or 3,447.12 board feet.

The DENR team found out that cutting was done in previous day, so they cannot identify the perpetrators or person who cut the said trees thus, considered abandoned forest products and issued with Apprehension Receipt. Moreover, this Office posted Notice of Apprehension in the vicinity and Barangay Hall and put said forest products under the temporary custody of the Barangay LGU-Tampus and for strict monitoring by this Office. Further investigation is still ongoing.

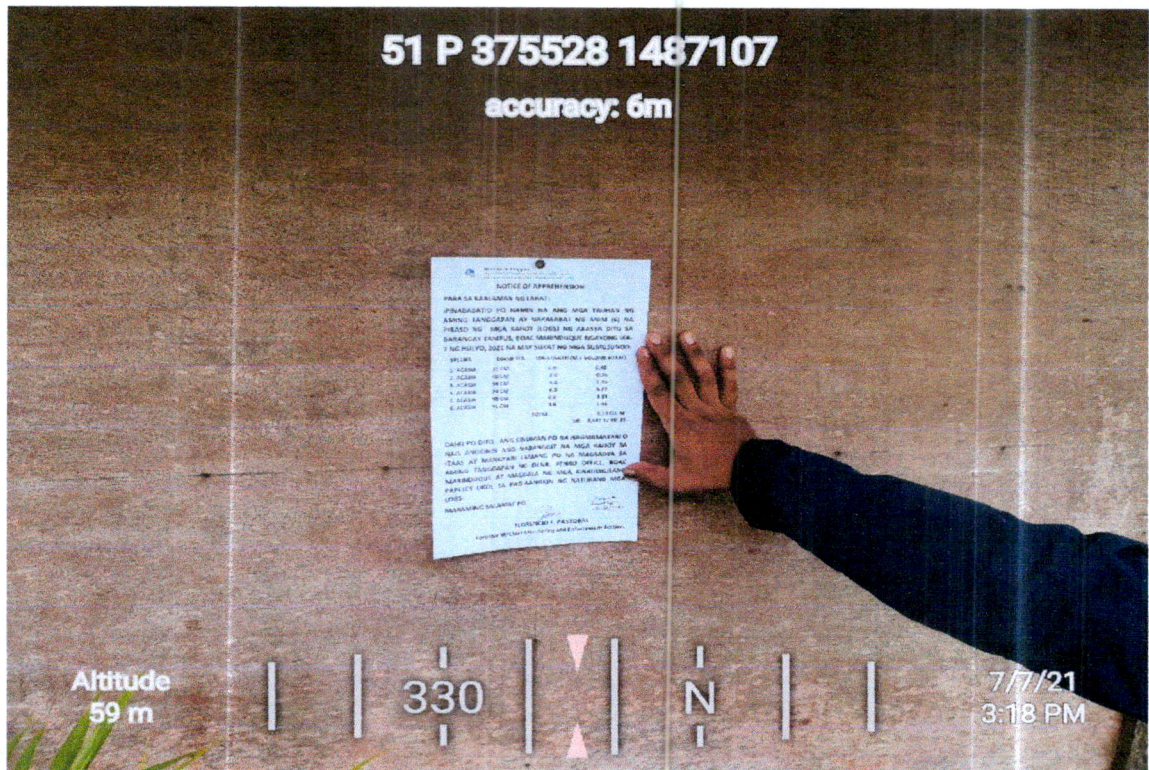
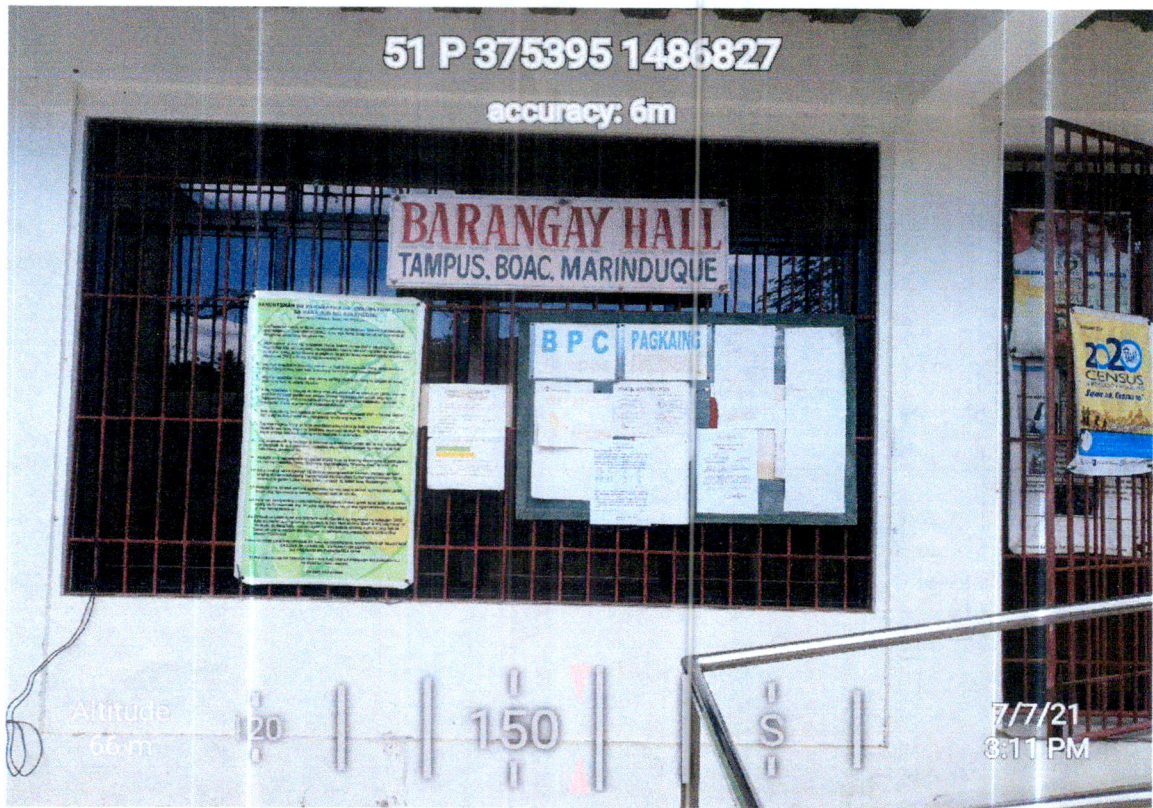
