Respectfully submitted is the report on the apprehension on illegal logging, wildlife and cases filed as of April 2021.

Please be informed that as of April 2021, there were 77 apprehensions made in the entire region with a total estimated fair market value of Php 1,856,683.34. Out of the 77 apprehensions made, 39 of which were assisted/initiated by the PNP/AFP. Also, a total of 12 units of Chainsaw were confiscated from the provinces of Oriental and Occidental Mindoro and Palawan. Below is the table of the summary of apprehensions, to wit:


