PRIVATE LAND TIMBER PERMIT

PLTP No. RIVB-17-2021

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 705, as amended, DAO No. 2000-21 "Revised Guidelines In The Issuance Of Private Land Timber Permit Special/Private Land Timber Permit (PLTP/SPLTP)" and DENR Administrative Order No. 2016-07 dated May 19, 2016 regarding the "DENR Manual of Authorities on Technical Matters", and to the existing Forestry laws, rules and regulations, is hereby granted to:

(Represented by Mrs. Eladia M. Mendoza, Atty-in-fact)

Citizen of the Republic of the Philippines, with permanent address at Sitio Acacia, Barangay Sta. Maria, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro to cut and utilize **ONE** (1) **NATURALLY GROWN DITA TREE** with a net harvestable volume of **0.46 cubic meter.**

This PERMIT is subject to pertinent Forestry laws, rules and regulations and including the terms and conditions set forth in the DENR Administrative Order No. 2000-21 dated February 28, 2000, and the following conditions shall be observed, to wit:

1. One (1) naturally grown Dita (Alstonia scholaris) tree within a private titled property covered by Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. 064-2014005266 located in Barangay Sta. Maria, Naujan, Oriental Mindoro, having a net harvestable volume of 0.46 cu.m after deducting the 30% allowance for internal defects and harvesting efficiency shall be authorized to be cut, as shown in the following table:

	Species	DBH (cm)	MH (m)	Net Volume (cu.m.)
1	Dita (Alstonia scholaris)	46	6	0.46

- 2. Prior to tree cutting operation, placards, or signboards with dimensions of 4 feet by 8 feet should be installed at conspicuous places to inform the public that the tree cutting operation is authorized by the DENR. Such notice of particulars should indicate the name of the permittee, the purpose of the activities to be undertaken and the number of trees to be cut;
- 3. The tree cutting operation shall at all times be under the direct supervision of the Regional Executive Director or his duly authorized representatives. The Regional Executive Director shall be administratively, civilly and criminally liable, should this Permit be used in any illegal purpose;
- The trees cut and parts thereof belong to the permittee. Provided, that in case of transport, necessary transport documents shall be secured from the Local DENR Field Office concerned;

- 5. The permittee shall replace the tree cut with one hundred (100) seedlings strictly of indigenous species in compliance with the DENR Memorandum Order (DMO) No. 2012-02 dated November 5, 2012 re: "Uniform Replacement for Cut and Relocated Trees" to be turned-over to the local DENR Field Office concerned in support to the National Greening Program (NGP) and climate change initiatives of the Government;
- The chainsaw that will be used in the felling/cutting operations shall be registered to the DENR pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9175 and its implementing rules and Regulations under DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2003-24 dated June 20, 2003;
- 7. The permittee is required to pay the forest charges for the naturally grown trees cut pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7161. The forest charges shall be based on the scaling after harvesting;
- 8. The permittee shall be required to undertake measures during and after cutting operation to mitigate the negative impacts of the said activity to the locality; and
- 9. Violation of any of the above conditions shall be sufficient ground for termination/cancellation of the permit, subject to due process without prejudice to the imposition of appropriate penalties pursuant to existing regulations.

This PERMIT is effective on the date of issuance and expires FIFTY (50) DAYS upon receipt of the permittee or as soon as the volume authorized herein is exhausted, whichever comes first.
