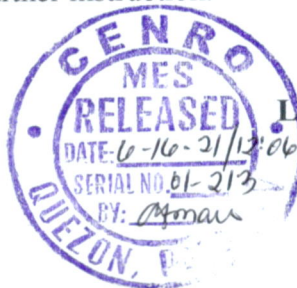
**SUBJECT :** **MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON JUNE 10, 2021 AT THE COVERED COURT OF BRGY. CALATEGAS, NARRA, PALAWAN RE: CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD ALLEGEDLY TRAVERSED A MANGROVE FOREST AREA IN PUROK PINAG-ISA, BRGY. CALATEGAS, NARRA, PALAWAN.**

Forwarded is the minutes of the meeting conducted last June 10, 2021 at the covered court of Bgy. Calategas, Narra, Palawan with the purpose to resolve issues anent construction of access road leading to the construction of Seawall Project thereat. It will be recalled that the issue was brought to the attention of DENR PENR Officer in a letter dated May 24, 2021 of Atty. Robert Chan, Executive Director of PNNI. Consequently, it was relayed to CENRO Quezon for proper action. This Office thru the In-Charge of Narra Station immediately conducted field investigation and result was forwarded on June 3, 2021. Along this line, a round table meeting among concerned agencies stakeholders/residents thereat was conducted on June 10, 2021 to come up resolution of the issue without prejudice to the environment and the interest of the public.

The meeting was attended by concerned officials of DENR CENRO Quezon, DENR Narra Station, DPWH, Municipal LGU of Narra, Barangay LGU of Calategas, 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District of Palawan, PNNI and some residents of Barangay Calategas. In that meeting, except for PNNI all participants have expressed their progressive support to the project. Given the fact that the subject area is within the Alienable and Disposable land characterized by a swampy area and mangrove species tends to grow, however, the road was constructed in slight zigzag direction to avoid damage of patches of back mangrove trees (landward species). Besides, prior to the construction of road, the proponent and concerned LGUs went through a process of series of public consultation and have secured waiver from affected residents.

Moreover, the field personnel who conducted the investigation are confident that the construction caused only minimal damage particularly of branches of trees along the edge of the road and no mangrove trees were cut or covered during the construction as they have conducted inspection and took geo-tagged pictures of the area **before and after road construction** to ensure that the road will traverse in open areas. Attached are geo-tagged pictures.

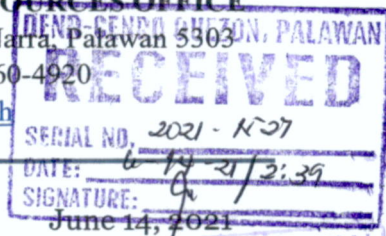

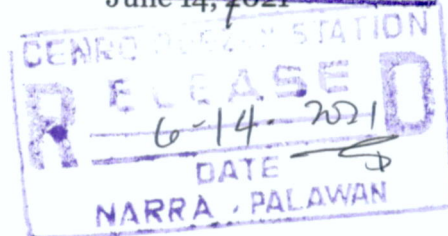



**MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON MAY 10, 2021 AT THE COVERED COURT OF BRGY. CALATEGAS, NARRA, PALAWAN RE: CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD WHICH ALLEGEDLY TRAVERSED A MANGROVE FOREST AREA IN PUROK PINAG-ISA, BRGY. CALATEGAS, NARRA, PALAWAN**

**INTRODUCTION**

In reference with the recommendation of the investigating team in their report dated May 31, 2021 appertaining the above road construction, on June 7, 2021, the CENR Officer of DENR CENRO Quezon, Palawan instructed the In-Charge of the DENR Narra Station to immediately pursue the recommendation of the team to hold a meeting with the stakeholders (i.e concerned LGU, DENR, PNNI, DPWH, Project Contractor and the affected community) to further discuss and try to resolve the issue at hand. Hence, this meeting on June 10, 2021.

**MEETING PROPER:**

The meeting was started at 2:30 in the afternoon with an invocation/doxology followed by singing of the National anthem.

Hon. Julie A. Burlaos, Barangay Captain of Calategas, Narra marked the opening of the meeting by welcoming the attendance of the following participants, namely: CENR Officer Leonard T. Caluya; CENRO Quezon Narra Station In-charge, Pablo L. Cruz and its staff; DPWH Project Engr. Orlando Rodriguez and staff; representative of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District of Palawan in the person of SB Narra Cenon Garcia; PTK Contractor Representative, Engr. Esperancilla; Mr. Teofilo Tredez and company from PNNI, members of the Barangay Council of Calategas and some residents of Barangay Calategas who are in the meeting.

The barangay Chair expressed his sentiments that some of his constituents instead of being grateful of the seawall project for its numerous benefits, are against the project. He does not expect that they would received negative comments and even brought it to the social media when in fact, the rest of community will benefit from it in many ways. He also mentioned that all the while, the project will be implemented smoothly as this had undergone consultation process on April 23, 2021 coupled by the favorable stands and support of the adjacent residents directly affected by the road construction as they are no longer walking in a swampy area during high tides in going to and from their residential houses.

CENRO Leonard T. Caluya, acknowledged and expressed his thanks to the meeting participants. He also mentioned why the DENR personnel who are in this meeting are on red shirts is because, today, June 10, 2021, the DENR is celebrating its 34<sup>th</sup> Founding Anniversary. The CENRO right away spoke on the rationale why this

meeting was called for. He further mentioned that barangay Calategas is very fortunate to have this kind of seawall project as not all seacoast barangays who are seeking project like this are not being given fund due to limited financial resource especially during this pandemic virus period. He is saddened by the issues raised by the some sectors but clarified that in order to start the construction of the seawall project, construction of an access way is unavoidable. This is where the issue came up. The CENRO, however, disclosed that in the investigation report submitted, the area where the road construction took place falls within Alienable and Disposable land. He also made mentioned that in any development project of public interest, the so called collateral damage is indispensable much so if the benefits of the project far outweigh the cost of damages. Hence, our office has called this meeting to come up with resolution that would address the concerned of the opposing side/sector so that the seawall project could proceed.

SB Member Cenon Garcia spoke in behalf of 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District, Atty. Cyrille A. Zaldivar who have exerted effort and endorsed this project. He mentioned that aside from being a buffer against storm surge and coastal protection, this development project can contribute in the socio-economic well-being of the community. He said that Barangay Calategas is so lucky to have this seawall project. He begged the support of the community for the project.

Engr. Orlando Rodriguez, project engineer of DPWH 2<sup>nd</sup> District Office, greeted everyone. He briefly discussed the perspective/objective of the project. He also shared that this project proposal was started in 2018 with all the considerations. Accordingly, the pandemic virus had caused delay in its implementation. He is, however, very dismayed on the negative feedbacks from some individuals who are not seemingly aware on the benefits the project will bring in the area. He knows the project very well not only as the project engineer but also he is a bonafide resident of Barangay Calategas.

Engr. Rodriguez explained that in every development project there is always collateral damage to be sacrificed in exchange for greater community progress. He said that we may have damage some of the mangroves but it could turn more favors and opportunities to the locals, lessen and ease some burdens in terms of transportation and a lot more as the area accordingly is swampy during high tides and or during the occurrence of heavy rains. He further mentioned that to his recall, the area of the road during his childhood is devoid of any trees.

Mr. Teofilo Tredez from PNNI and also a resident of Brgy. Calategas expressed their opposition on the project. He mentioned that the seawall project is far less not so important in the area citing that there are other development projects that could be done in their barangay. He also underscored that the project did not undergo a



thorough studies and public consultation. He made mentioned if the project proponent and or the contractor had secured and complied all the requirements and documents needed before they started the road construction.

Engr. Esperancilla of PTK Inc. (Project Contractor) when asked on the progress of the project explained that to date, they had stopped their road construction works because of the access road issue. She said that the road was purposely constructed to provide an access way to the approved Flood Control Mitigating structure Project of the DPWH under the TRAIN program of the government. Accordingly, the road lines/location is formerly an access trail being regularly used by the residents in the area in going to and from their houses, thus, the residents are very grateful when the road was put in place because they no longer leave their motor vehicles in a high ground area during high tides. Engr. Esperacilla further uttered that the construction of the access road is not included in the budget of the seawall project. The road is a necessity to bring in their supplies and materials, machineries and equipment to start the seawall project and, likewise, addressed the recurring problem of the adjacent residents in the area during high waters. She also assured that their company will turn-over the road project to the Barangay once the project is completed for the use of the residents.

The last to speak in the program is the In-Charge of the Narra Station in the person of Pablo L. Cruz. He briefly narrated the reasons why their personnel investigated the access road issue. He also mentioned that one of the findings in the investigation report conducted/submitted by the DENR personnel regarding the land classification of the area which is Alienable and Disposable land. He further explained that it is normal to see or witness mangrove trees on A&D lands because of the nature of its self-regeneration which is a Seed Tree System or the Mother Tree system, meaning the mangrove tree species that have grown in the area may have come from the seeds of trees from the adjacent mangrove forest/timberland area thru the agents of seed dispersal.

Mr. Cruz added that the team's findings were based on their actual observation on May 28, 2021 in the area. He lamented that their team is not bias in the conduct of their investigation. That if there are questionable data in their findings, the team is willing to redo the investigation with the presence of other stakeholders in the area.

#### Question and answer portions:

1. Mr. Teofilo Tredez reiterated that he is against the construction of sea wall project. He also asked if the sea wall project is really the need of the residents, why not prioritizing the farm to market road instead?

Engr. Responded that having a sea wall project is very beneficial especially to the residents near the coastal area and the project cannot be converted to farm

to market road since it was downloaded from the Regional Office for the above purpose.

Why did they allow the cutting of mangroves for this project instead of campaigning to plant it to support the programs of the government?

Engr. Rodriguez answered that if the issue here is the cutting of mangrove because of the project. Why do you not question the erection of houses using mangrove trees? Where does their waste go, how's the sanitation there? Taking consideration that the collateral damage in the area would bring improvement and development.

2. Freddie Capispisan, asked if how does this sea wall affects the fisherman livelihood. Is it still free to dock here?

Engr. Rodriguez explained that there will be measures of having mechanical ways of lifting the boat in case of docking along the sea wall so it would be much easier for the fishermen to secure their boats. Engr. He also suggested that the barangay or the fisherfolks must formulate rules and regulations on how to maintain the use the sea wall.

In addition, the design of the seawall project is with a baywalk to provide recreation in the area comparable to the Puerto Princesa City baywalk. This can generate income in the community.

Does this project affect or covers the dried fish area of fisherfolks?

Engr. Rodriguez assured the residents that there will be no destruction of houses and fish drier in the area because the sea wall will be constructed along the seashore.

3. Luisito Rubio, Alfonso Diaz, Bambie Amador and Hernie Zoliva stood and agreed in the construction of sea wall but requested to start the project in the southeastern part. They believed that this development project could bring improvement in the barangay.

The Barangay Chair acknowledged and replied that the project had undergo a thorough studies. This project would help to control the movement of water in the area. He also shared that he accepted this project not for personal benefits but for the benefits of the majority of the people in their barangay. This project needs support from the community.

CENRO Caluya gave the closing remarks saying that barangay Calategas should be very thankful for being a recipient of this kind of development project. However, he encouraged the community to carefully weigh its benefits and effect to the environment. For the community to also be wary and watchful on other environmental issues in their area. He expressed hope that this meeting had gave clarifications on the



issues raised. Lastly, he encouraged the supports and cooperation of the community in this project undertakings for the betterment of the majority and the barangay as a whole.

The meeting was ended at 5:00 in the afternoon. The host expressed their appreciation and thanks to everyone for their participations.

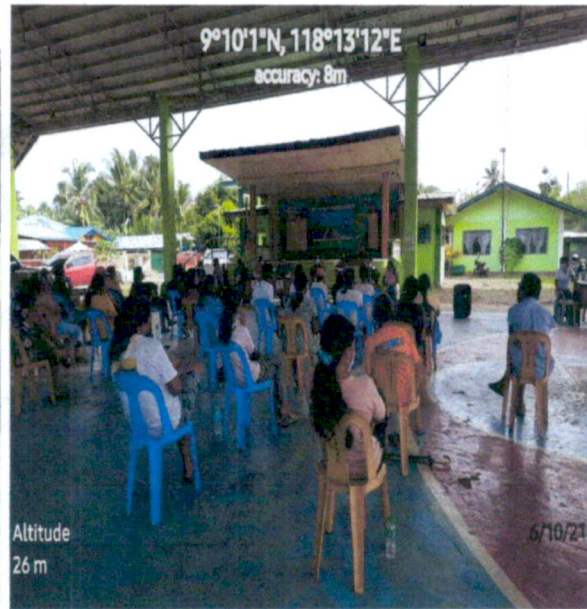

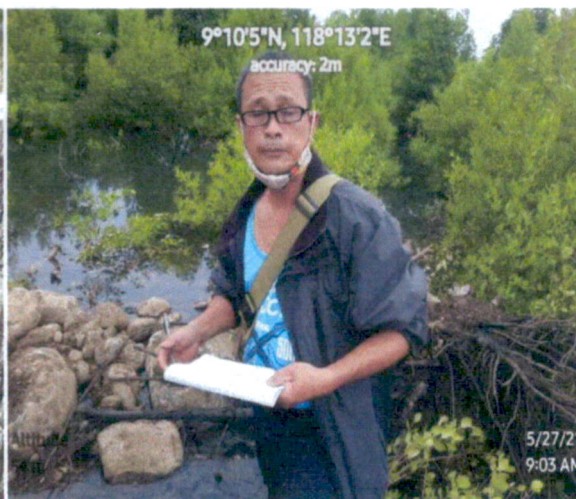
