OCCUPATION FEES ON FORESHORE AREAS

Considering the unregulated occupation and massive use of foreshore lands, this office is much willing to actively participate in the collection of occupation fees over foreshore called for under Lands General Circular No. 58, Series 1979 covered by an instruction of the Undersecretary for Field Operations in his memorandum dated January 06, 2021 (Annex A).

Pending issuance of clarificatory policy on appraisal, re-appraisal and collection of occupation fees on foreshore lands, our CENRO offices are burdened on how to accomplish the assigned targets on the matter due to the checklist of documentary requirements from that office to support approval of appraisal (Annex B).

Attached are copies of the memorandum from CENRO Brooke's Point dated January 29, 2021 and CENRO Coron dated February 10, 2021 (Annexes C and D) both requesting the transfer of targets for appraisal and re-appraisal for reasons stated.

Hereunder are suggested documentary requirements to support approval of appraisal and the additional requirements in the final processing and approval of permits and agreements for foreshore lands.

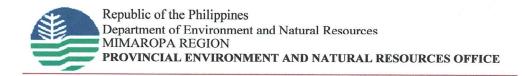

ACCOMPLISHMENT ON PATENT PROCESSING / ISSUANCE AND IN THE SUBMISSION OF ITS CATCH-

UP PLAN

Relative the above subject submitted are the following justification to wit:

- A. For very slow and low accomplishment on patent processing and approval/issuance of patents the following are the contributing factors:
 - 1. The lifting of suspension in patent processing and issuance signed on March 2, 2020 covers only 8 municipalities particularly:
 - 1.1 Culion is found to have extended Lot surveys within Timberlands, A/D lands although fully developed are not qualified under Free Patent due to late release from T.L to A/D Lands.
 - 1.2 Rizal has very limited potential, 80% are Timberland barangays.
 - 1.3 Busuanga & Roxas are almost saturated with minimal potentials
 - 1.4 Balabac with Cad survey pending approved at Region Office.
 - 1.5 Narra & Brookes Pt. are likewise saturated with extended surveys in T.L and with old surveys which need deeper research/verification.
 - 2. Unlike MIMARO, Surveys and Patent Processing in Palawan undergo very tedious process brought about by DMC 2019-10 of December 11, 2019 and adversely operating with equal unit-costing, thus:
 - 2.1 Because of erroneous survey record, all potential lots are subject to LC verification of the CENRO, review verification of the PENRO, the Chief Surveys Division & confirmation/clearance of ARD TS before PLA processing

residents and government issued ID. These documents are not controlled by DENR and non compliance of the above shall be administratively and criminally liable, hence our accomplishments are at the mercy of other agencies and by the level of interest of applicant to complete the required documents.

 Record shows that originally we are assigned only of residential Free Patent however upon request to include Agricultural Patent to form part of the MOV, a separate target for Agricultural Patent was assigned, opposite of the request.

B. For submitting a Catch-up Plan

A catch-up plan is scheduled up to June 31, 2021 assuming that the Regional Office, the LMB and the OSEC shall relax some of the requirements called under DMC 2019-10 such as.

- 1. Barangay Certification to be no longer notarized
- 2. To relax the Joint Affidavit of two residents in addition to Joint Affidavit in prescribed B.L Form
- 3. Comm. Tax Certificate (CTC) or Govt. issued I.D
- 4. LRA clearance for PSU survey only
- 5. Importantly, to provide new sets of cleansed Cadastral maps certified by the Chief, Surveys Division and approved by ARD TS to address the long processes in LC Verification and to serve as permanent record.
- 6. Likewise anticipating the extension of Free Patent Law.
