Respectfully submitting hereunder is the explanation of the undersigned to the incident on the burning of speed boat of the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS), Taytay, to wit;

- 1. That before the incident took place, the undersigned instructed our Boatman and Boat swain to conduct regular check-up of the speed boat. The said employee was also instructed to take care and diligently maintain the said government conveyance. Early this quarter, the engine oil of said speed boat was replaced ready for seaborne patrol and monitoring activities;
- 2. That the said speedboat has been operated by a skilled boatman hired by this office as Job Order personnel, wherein due diligence of a good father of a family in the selection and supervision of such personnel together with the Park Rangers had been exercised in the performance of duties and functions;
- 3. That early morning of February 5, 2021, we received an information from a concerned citizen regarding the on-going illegal trawl fishing activity in So. Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian, Taytay and within the administrative jurisdiction of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS) per Presidential Proclamation No. 342 dated July 12, 2000;
- 4. That during the conduct of seaborne patrolling and monitoring activities, the team headed by Forest Ranger Ricardo S. Tandoc recovered four (4) trawl nets illegally used by the fisherman in front of Puting Buhangin and So. Pinagpala in Barangay Alacalian, The apprehended fishing paraphernalia's were stocked at the Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) for safekeeping purposes.

- 5. That after the enforcement activities, our boat man and boat swain properly anchored the speedboat on the designated docking area in front of the PAM Office;
- 6. That on the same day, at around 9:15 PM the rest of team composed of Forest Ranger Ricardo S. Tandoc and Forest Protection Officer Rocky Dalabajan heard the shout of the neighbors including that of Punong Barangay Delia E. Fajardo that the speedboat is burning at the docking area of our office. However, and considering that our personnel have no firearms and that the crime occurred during nighttime, our staff conducted first an assessment whether the culprit is still at the crime scene considering that there is an assumption that the act committed with the aid of armed person;
- 7. That upon learning that the culprit were already gone, the team together with the help of the neighbors immediately went to the crime scene to stop the fire in the engine and the back of the speed boat. Subsequently, the team heard a boat heading to Barangay Alacalian with more or less, three to four persons aboard shouting "Yehey!! Yehey!!", celebrated simultaneously with an explosion like a gun fire;
- 8. That after the incident and during the rest of the night, our personnel observed some unusual activities not only in the coastal area but also along the Barangay road, the presence of some pump boats and motorcycle just like observing their activity;
- 9. That on the next day, February 6, 2021, the incident was reported to the Punong Barangay, Municipal Station and Bureau of Fire and Protection (BFP). Likewise, the personnel of the BFP went to the area and conducted investigation of the crime; and
- 10. That the said incident is unexpected and it is impossible to avoid considering that the culprit act with malice and took advantage of night time to facilitate the commission of the crime. Aside to this, there is an abuse of superior strength in the part of the culprit wherein the crime having been committed by the three or four persons in conspiracy with one another. Further, the act is also committed with evident premeditation and with the use of conveyance.

In view of the foregoing circumstances, considering that said incident is unexpected and which was resulted from the strict implementation of protected area laws, rules and regulations and in line with the fulfilment of our duty, the undersigned prayed for to clear and

AT MSPLS-PAM OFFICE, BARANGAY OLD GUINLO, TAYTAY,

PALAWAN

Please be informed that on the morning of February 5, 2021, we received an information from a concerned citizen regarding an on-going illegal trawl fishing activity in So. Pinagpala, Barangay Alacalian, Taytay, Palawan. The team immediately responded and proceeded to the area to conduct seaborne patrol. Upon arrival to the reported area, no trawlers were monitored however; four (4) trawl nets were recovered by the team in front of Puting buhangin and So. Pinagpala in Barangay Alacalian. The team continued to patrol around the area and at around 10:47 AM, the team decided to return to the PAM-Office and recorded and stocked the trawl nets for safekeeping purposes.

On the night of the same day, at around 9:15 PM the team heard the shout of the neighbors including that of Punong Barangay Delia E. Fajardo that the speed boat is burning at the docking area of PAMO-MSPLS. The team, together with the help of the neighbors immediately went to the boat to stop the fire in the engine and back of the speed boat, we stopped the fire at around 9:25 PM. We also heard a boat heading to Alacalian shouting "Yehey!! Yehey!!". More or less, there are three persons aboard that boat. I immediately informed the CENR Officer Allan L. Valle and Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) Clarissa P. Pador thru phone call to report the incident. The next day, February 6, 2021, the team reported the incident to the Barangay, Municipal Police Station and Bureau of Fire and Protection (BFP). The personnel of the Bureau of Fire went to the area to conduct investigation. We already requested to furnish this office a copy of the results of the investigation.
