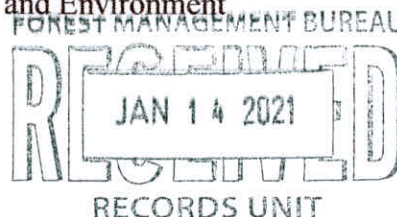

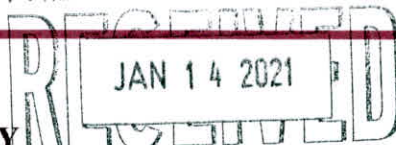

Respectfully forwarded is the Memorandum dated September 22, 2020 of PENRO Marinduque and its enclosures regarding the above subject.

Please be informed that PENRO Marinduque conducted a Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee Meeting at the DENR-PENRO Conference Hall, Boac, Marinduque on September 21, 2020. Said meeting was participated by various agencies such as other government agencies (OGAs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Academe, private sectors, and other institutions. They are partners of the DENR in forest protection and implementation of ENR laws in the province.

The meeting agenda focused on the polishing of contents of the PMFPC Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and set the schedule of signing. It was also agreed by the body to invite the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) and Department of Information and Technology (DICT) as additional members of PMFPC.

It was also discussed the deputation order of PNP personnel and agreed to have separate training. Further, it was noted that the PMFPC TWG should be composed of representatives from the DENR and partner agencies as well as to designate one (1) PMFPC Desk Officer or secretariat to assure the close coordination between PMFPC members.

Attached is the photo documentation, minutes of the meeting, approved Resolution no. 01-2020 dated September 21, 2020, and draft Memorandum of Agreement for your reference. Documentation on the said meeting also serves as means of verification per approved WFP 2020 of PENRO Marinduque.

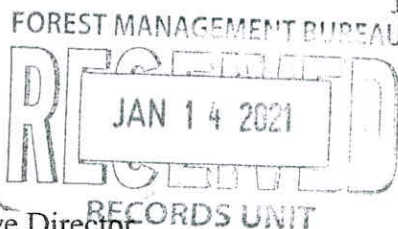



SUBJECT : **INTENSIFYING AND STRENGTHENING FOREST PROTECTION ACTIVITIES OF THE FIELD OFFICES**



Provided is the Memorandum from the Undersecretary for Field Operations and Environment dated December 03, 2020 pertaining to the recent typhoons that hit the identified priority watersheds in Luzon specifically the Upper Marikina River Basin Protected Landscape (UPMRBPL), Bicol River Basin, and Cagayan River Basin from October to November 2020. The said phenomena emphasized the much needed interventions to mitigate the impact of typhoons that could affect the downstream portion of the watershed and its surrounding communities.

In this regard, you are hereby instructed to intensify and strengthen the forest protection activities within your area of jurisdiction. Ensure that all existing Forest Product Monitoring Stations are manned 24/7 fully supported with logistical requirements. You are also directed to assign **ALL FOREST RANGERS** in the Enforcement Unit to strictly implement the Lawin Forest and Biodiversity Protection System and Environment and Natural Resources (ENR) laws in your respective area of jurisdiction.
