Greetings of good health from the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP)!

We are pleased to invite nominations from your agency to the Public Management Development Program (PMDP) Middle Managers Class (MMC) Batch 27 which will open on 02 August 2021 under a flexible learning mode.

The MMC is designed for Division Chiefs (SG 24) or those in equivalent positions who are in succession for 3rd level posts. Designated OIC-Division Chiefs for at least a year are also eligible for nomination. The MMC is also open to high-performing and high-potential individuals with SG 23 to SG 18. All nominees must not be older than 50 years old.

Accepted applicants will be mentored closely by prominent and seasoned pracademics – practitioners and academics - from the public and private sectors. After their six-month online training, the scholars will implement a Capstone Project that will hopefully impact the delivery of your critical services. The completion of the PMDP will effectively prepare the scholars for career executive positions in the government. Should they satisfy the academic requirements, scholars will also earn a Master in Development Management degree under a ladderized scheme.

PMDP virtual classes are scheduled from Monday to Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM with synchronous and asynchronous sessions continuously for three weeks per month. Given the rigor of the program and per policy set by the NGCESDP Steering Committee, scholars shall be considered on study leave for the duration of the six-month intensive online training. Participating agencies are also encouraged to provide scholars internet access e.g. data allowance in lieu of the transportation expenses which was usual agency counterpart in the face-to-face set-up, to ensure uninterrupted participation.

We will highly appreciate receiving the nominations from your agency on or before 21 June 2021. The admission requirements of the nominees should be submitted via bit.ly/pmdponlinesubmissionsMMC.
