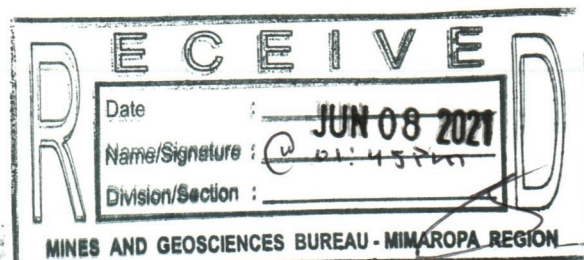

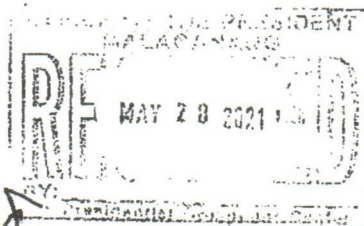

Ang paghahakot ng mga *Off.* BATO ay nangyari po noong 2015, isang dating kagawad ng ibang barangay na si LALAIN DINO, ay nagtungo sa aming Barangay at nagpahakot ng mga bato.

Sumunod na pangyayari ay noong nakaraan taon, *Off.* ²⁰²⁰ nakita ng aking kapatid na may grupo ng mga kalalakihan na naghahakot ng buhangin sa dalampasigan, ito ay kanilang isinasako at isinasakay sa Bangka. Sinabihan ko ang aking kapatid na kung sakali ay may sumunod pang gumawa ng illegal na pag-quarry, kung maaari ay makunan nya na ng picture o video na maaring magpatotoo.

Kaya naman ng makita ng aking Bayaw na meron muling grupo ng kalalakihan na nagsasalandra ng buhangin at isinasako ang mga pebbles na

nasalandra, sinabi niya ito sa kanyang asawa na akin kapatid na si Leomy Ferriol Bonifacio.

Nagtungo sa dalampasigan ang aking kapatid at nakita nga niya ang mga tao na kasama ang dating kagawad na si JOSEPH DELOS SANTOS. Inutusan ng aking kapatid ang kanyang anak na pumunta ng Barangay at ireport ito sa Kapitan.

Nakunan ito ng video at nasabi ng isang Bantay Dagat na ito ay alam ng Kapitan, lumapit ang aking kapatid sa mga tao upang ipatigil ang sinasabing illegal na Gawain subalit sinabi ng dating kagawad na ito ay hindi nila gagawin kung walang Pahintulot ng kapitan ng Barangay Banilad na si Kap. Joselito Jasa Perlas at nagpatuloy sila sa kanilang ginagawa.

Dahil ditto, ipinaalam ito sa akin ng aking kapatid. Naiintindihan ko na mali at bawal ang kanilang ginagawa, dahil ang ating Pangulo ay nag-utos na isaayos at pagandahin ang Boracay, kaya dapat proteksyunan at ingatan ang dalampasigan. Ang aming lugar ay isang white beach kung saan may dating malawak na baybayin subalit lumiliit ito dahil sa ganitong mga illegal na gawain.

Ang Mayor ng Maynila ay gumawa ng paraan ang kanilang dalampasigan na magkaroon ng white sand, isinasaayos nila upang mapaganda ang tanawin, kaya kami ay bless na magkaroon ng ganitong likas na ganda ng tanawin, hindi ba dapat naming itong ingatan at pangalagaan. Lubos ang aming pagmamalasakit.

HL. Subalit sa aming lugar hinahayaan ang ganitong pagsira , paghakot ng mga BUHANGIN na protekson ng baybaying dagat.

Nang ma-ipost ko ang nasabing video nagsimula na ang HARASSMENT sa aming pamilya at puro pananakot at nagsabi pa sa aming buong pamilya si kapitan Joselito Perlas na puti na ang buhok sa bilangguan ay hindi pa rin kami makakalaya at magbabayad kami ng milyon.

Kaya naman po sumulat na po ako sa inyong tanggapan upang maimbestigahan ang mga pangyayari, at humihiling po kaming tulong na matigil ang harassment sa amin habang umuusad ang imbestigasyon.

Hinihiling po naming sa inyong tanggapan na huwag sanang magagamit ng Punong Barangay ang kanyang kapangyarihan takutin na huwag magsalita ang mga tao upang lumabas ang katotohanan. Pananakot at tapang po ang ginagamit ng Punong Barangay dahil isa siyang retiradong sundalo at lagi kaming dinadaan sa harassment at sinasabing ikakaso at pagbabayaran kami ng milyon dahil sa nasabing pag-post ng video. Na nakasira sa kanila. Mali po bang malaman, magmalasakit at manawagan ng tulong at gamitin ang sarili kong account sa FB upang iparating ito sa kinauukulan.

Nalaman ko mula sa asawa ni JOSEPH DELOS SANTOS , na si LORILYN DELOS SANTOS na aking nakausap noong meeting naming sa SAMAHAN NG KABABAIHAN. Nabanggit niya po sa akin at aking narinig ng malinaw na ang sabi niya po ay trabaho lamang ang ginawa ng kanyang asawa at ng mga kasamahan. Sabi niya ay hindi sila maghahakot kung hindi nagpaalam ang bosing nila na si RONNIE PEREZ, na may-ari ng BEACH RESORT sa may REKUDO PINAMALAYAN ORIENTAL MINDORO kay Kapitan ng Banilad na si Joselito Jasa Perlas.

Kung walang kinalaman ang Punong Barangay dito bakit niya tinolerate ang maling Gawain, Sana maimbestigahan ang illegal na Gawain ito sa aming Barangay pati ang mga taong gumawa at sangkot dito.

Kalakip nito ang mga larawan na kaugnay sa mga pangyayari. Umaasa po ako kasama ng aking pamilya sa inyong tulong at proteksyon.
