Presentation of completed projects in MIMARO under PRRD administration, 2016-2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Presentation of agency's completed projects should be a 3-5 minute AVP - If there are projects to be turned over to beneficiaries, RD or ARD may present - All AVPs will be submitted to PIA MIMAROPA and RTF Secretariat. 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Site Preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - OP-EMC will select the final venue of the event - DILG MIMAROPA will coordinate with the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro and City Government of Calapan and propose at least three possible venues - The following must be considered in identifying possible venues: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • wide space for setting up of registration area, antigen testing area, seats of participants, and stage • parking space for presidential convoy • triage space - OP-EMC and PSG will conduct ocular inspection on November 15 (Monday) - PGOOrM will assist OP-EMC and PSG during the ocular visit

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Safety and Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - DOH MIMAROPA recommends inter-Province and City Government collaboration in conducting antigen testing - RT-PCR test should be done at least two-days before the event (Nov. 16) - PGOOrM will inform RTF Secretariat and participants regarding updates and schedule of RT-PCR testing in the province - The following hospitals in Calapan City can conduct RT-PCR testing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OMPH • MMG - Participants should bring and present a printed copy of the RT-PCR test result to the Secretariat/PSG/DOH during registration to be able to undergo antigen testing

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Inputs to CORDS Presentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Concerned agencies/offices and LGUs should provide highlights of accomplishments in the MIMARO provinces. Data and information may include statistics, trends, and other necessary inputs - Accomplishment are not purely ELCAC related but should also consider completed projects and programs under PRRD's administration (2016-2022) - All accomplishments/inputs to CORDS presentation should be sent to the RTF Secretariat, copy furnished Dr. Din Mabanta.
