This is to acknowledge the receipt of the Memorandum dated 12 October 2021 regarding the submission of Apprehension Report on Illegal Logging and Cases Filed for the month of September 2021.

It has been observed that the estimated market value for each incident of apprehended and/or seized undocumented forest products was not indicated. Moreover, please be reminded to update the status of the administrative adjudication proceedings for each incident of apprehension and/or seizure of undocumented forest products including conveyances, tools and equipment as provided under DAO 97-32.

In addition, please be advised to use simultaneously the e-FMS in recording apprehended/ seized and/or confiscated undocumented forest products and other subsequent actions pursuant to the Memorandum dated 29 June 2021 signed by Assistant Secretary for Enforcement.

Finally, future similar reports on wildlife e.g. illicit wildlife trade must be forwarded to the Biodiversity Management Bureau.

MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2021**

Respectfully submitted is the apprehension report on illegal logging, wildlife trading and cases filed for the month of September 2021.

Please be informed that for the month of September, there were a total of 38 apprehensions made in the entire region with more than half in the province of Palawan. The PNP assisted/initiated fourteen (14) apprehensions, mostly in the province of Oriental Mindoro.

Said 38 apprehensions had a total estimated fair market value of **Php302,254.47** for the forest products alone excluding the market value of the apprehended units of chainsaw and conveyances. There were 14 units of chainsaw and eight (8) units of conveyances apprehended. No apprehension on log/timber was reported for the month of September. Further, there is one (1) reported apprehension on wildlife from the province of Palawan which was subsequently turned-over to the PCSD on the same day of apprehension.

Below are the matrixes of summary of Apprehensions for the month of September 2021 (Table 1), and new Cases Filed for the month of September 2021 (Table 2).
