SUBJECT : REQUEST FOR PARTICIPANTS TO THE 3RD WILDLIFE LAW ENFORCEMENT SUMMIT ON NOVEMBER 16-18, 2021

The DENR through the Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB), in partnership with the DENR-ADB/GEF IWT PROJECT will be organizing the 3rd Wildlife Law Enforcement (WLE) Summit to be held virtually on **16-18 November 2021**. The DENR personnel and staff from other government agencies and civil society organizations who form part of the wildlife enforcement network in the country will be gathered together for this three-day event.

The summit aims to provide a venue for information exchange on experiences, lessons learned, best practices, and challenges on wildlife law enforcement operation in various regions of the country. It will also serve as an avenue to discuss the current developments with regard to policies, capacity buildings, assessment tools and information systems that will help in the improvement of wildlife law enforcement in the Philippines. Further, it will document valuable information on wildlife law enforcement in aide of enhancing enforcement strategies and guidelines in the country.

Relative thereto, we would like to request representatives from the Region and Field Offices to participate in the said summit. The participants must be involved in wildlife law enforcement and had participated in any of the Training of Trainers on the Application of the Wildlife Law Enforcement Manual of Operations conducted from 2011-2019 and Basic Wildlife Law Enforcement Training held last year (see attached list).
