Background

AP-PLAT was established at the 2018 G20 summit in Japan with the vision of helping Asia-Pacific countries to build a climate-resilient and sustainable society. Its activities revolve around: 1) developing scientific knowledge and information related to climate change impacts in the region; 2) providing support tools for stakeholders engaged in policy-making; and 3) providing capacity-building on climate change impact assessment and formulation of adaptation projects.

In relation to this, the collab aims to present useful scientific tools and online capacity-building services available in AP-PLAT and discuss potential areas for collaboration/synergy between AP-PLAT and Partnerships in Environmental Management for the Seas of East Asia (PEMSEA) and the role of the Institute for Global Environmental Strategies (IGES) Japan as a PEMSEA Regional Center of Excellence and promoter of capacity-building activities in AP-PLAT.
