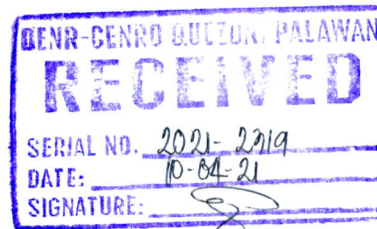

COASTAL CLEAN-UP (ICC) DAY HELD ON SEPTEMBER 18,
2021**



I. BACKGROUND

Presidential Proclamation No. 470, series of 2003 declares the third Saturday of September of each year as the International Coastal Clean-up (ICC) Day in observance of the Global Coastal Clean-up celebrations.

This yearly environmental celebration is considered as the world's largest volunteer effort to clean our ocean and waterways which call for towns and cities to participate in cleaning of coastlines as a symbol of commitment in protecting our oceans and its rich biodiversity against pollution.

With this year's theme, "*Understand and Beat Marine Pollution*", and in adherence to the United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development (2021-2030) with the message, "*The Science We Need for the Ocean We Want*", this Office successfully conducted a clean-up activity held along the shoreline of Sitio Labangan, Bgy. Tabon, Quezon, Palawan on September 18, 2021. It was made possible in coordination with the Barangay Council of Tabon, Quezon, Palawan led by *Punong Barangay* Ruthie Sunayan.

Moreover, this Office also supported the International Coastal Clean-up celebration and Launching of Quezon Bicycle Transportation Promotion Ordinance spearheaded by LGU-Quezon on the same date held at Lasyap Beach, Bgy. Maasin, Quezon, Palawan by sending off seven (7) CENRO personnel in behalf of this Office.



These activities aims to combat the issue of marine debris, raise awareness on marine pollution, improve waste management and an action to inspire people on the desire for a cleaner, safer and healthier ocean. Said activities were conducted while observing strict compliance on the Local IATF protocols and guidelines in response to government efforts to combat COVID-19.

II. HIGHLIGHTS

A. Kick-Off Activity

Bgy. Tabon, Quezon, Palawan

The activity commenced at 7:30 in the morning with a short program on site. Hon. Kgd. Jackman Alonsagay of Tabon graced the opening of the program with her warm message to all the volunteers who showed enthusiasm for the activity followed by a short message given by SEMS Zosima Jampit from the EMB who discussed the importance of ICC emphasizing the impact of proper waste segregation to achieve trash-free seas. In his inspirational message, CENR Officer Leonard T. Caluya also expressed his gratitude for all the volunteers who participated the activity. He further emphasized that regular clean-ups shall be conducted, not only during the ICC but shall always begin within the premises of every household.

B. Participants/Volunteers

Forty-eight (48) volunteers (*17 male, 31 female*) from DENR-CENRO Quezon and residents of Bgy. Tabon gathered together and participated the clean-up drive.

C. Trash Collected

Twelve (12) sacks of trash were collected within an approximate 500 meters distance cleaned. Trash collected by the Municipal Garbage Truck was disposed to Municipal Sanitary Landfill for residuals and MRF for recyclables.

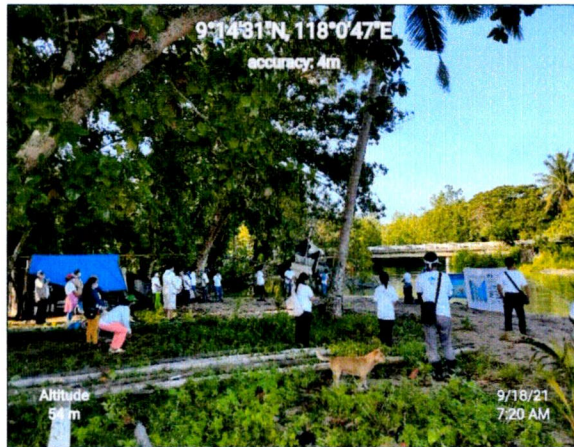

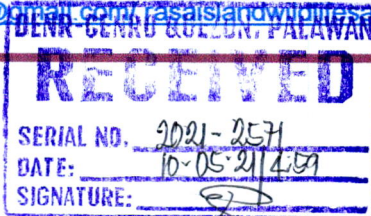

In celebration of the International Coastal Clean-up 2021 with a theme “Understand and Beat Marine Pollution”, the DENR-Narra Station and PAMO - RIWS personnel together with the barangay officials and some residents of Brgys. of Panacan and Panacan II conducted coastal clean-up along the coastal areas of said barangays.

The said clean – up activity started at exactly 7 AM was successfully completed at around 9:30 in the morning of September 18, 2021.

A total of 7 sacks which is approximately 25 kilos of garbage were collected in the coastal area of the said barangays. Most of the garbage collected were from anthropogenic wastes (i.e. diapers, junk food plastics) and fishing materials (tattered nylon, plastics of ices and fishes).
