The Biodiversity Management Bureau is organizing a training course which intends to develop the cave diving skills of selected personnel within the DENR as a basic prerequisite in the assessment and monitoring of underwater caves. Pursuant to the Cave Act (RA9072), this course is also in line with the Bureau's mandate to build capacities in the conservation, management and protection of the country's cave and cave resources, including those found underwater. Underwater caves have been recorded in various regions all over the country and more are yet to be identified.

To orient the DENR personnel in underwater cave assessment and monitoring, the cave diving course will include an online session that can be participated in by field personnel from Regions who might also have underwater caves. The on-site skills development sessions, however, can be extended only to the three pre-selected participants who will carry on the training until its third level and serve as trainors/resource person for successive courses.

In view of this, we would like to open the invitation to the online sessions of the Foundational Underwater Cave Diving to be held on 8-9 November 2021 at 9AM and request for five (5) technical staff from your Office, particularly those involved in the assessment of caves, and including those with diving skills, to participate.
