1. The National Task Force – ELCAC would like to highlight notable accomplishments of the Regional Task Forces (RTFs) and Clusters as well as the leadership and heads of the different organized mechanisms/structures, behind the success of the Task Force for this year. These accomplishments will form part of the publication of the 2021 NTF-ELCAC Accomplishment Report. The objectives of the said Report are the following:
 - a. To inform the President and Cabinet members about the accomplishments of NTF-ELCAC for CY 2021;
 - b. To showcase the Duterte administration's good governance measures through a Whole-of-Government/Whole-of-Nation approach to counter the Communist Terrorist Group's more than five (5) decades of terror and atrocities;
 - c. To highlight the implementation of the Barangay Development Program as the flagship program of the NTF-ELCAC in conflict-affected communities and geographically isolated, and disadvantaged areas (GIDAs);
 - d. To identify measures and countermeasures to sustain the various programs and projects of the government in ending the communist insurgency in the country; and,
 - e. To share the best practices in the implementation of ELCAC-related programs in relation to the 12 Lines of Efforts.
2. In line with the preparation of the Report, the Clusters and RTFs will be given the option to feature their significant achievements following the required outline, as follows:
 - a. Joint Regional Task Forces (JRTFs)
 - i. Summary

- ii. ELCAC mechanisms/structure such as RTF composition, advisers, secretariat, QRT, etc.
- iii. Major Activities/ Programs implemented through the 12 Regional Clusters
- iv. Efforts of the Provincial Task Forces
- v. Best practices, if any
- vi. Ways Ahead/Catch-Up Plans/Recommendations
- vii. High resolution pictures with captions

b. National Clusters/Lines of Efforts

- i. Summary
- ii. ELCAC mechanisms/structure such as cluster composition, advisers, secretariat, QRT
- iii. Major Activities/ Programs implemented along its Sub Clusters
- iv. Best practices, if any
- v. Ways Ahead/Catch-Up Plans/Recommendations
- vi. High Resolution Pictures with Captions

3. The following will guide the Clusters and JRTFs in the submission of the required Reports:
 - a. The Reports shall be in Microsoft Word Document Format, and the Font in Verdana with font size ten (10).
 - b. The 12 Cluster Desk Officers and 17 JRTF Desk Officers shall be the primary coordinators, in close coordination with the Production Directorate, for the requirements to be submitted by the concerned Cluster and JRTFs.
 - c. The concerned Clusters and JRTFs shall provide the names of the primary and supernumerary representatives who shall serve as the Focal Persons to whom the Desk Officers and NTF Secretariat shall consult with to validate and finalize submitted reports.
 - d. The Clusters and JRTFs shall submit the first draft of the Report and other requirements, consisting of 15 pages, on or before November 1, 2021.
 - e. The final Report shall be approved and endorsed by the Focal Persons to the NTF Secretariat on or before December 15, 2021, for inclusion in the publication of the 2021 NTF-ELCAC Accomplishment Report.
 - f. The Publication shall take place for the period December 16-31, and the final product shall be distributed in January 2022.
