This has reference to your Memorandum dated 06 August 2021 forwarding the Memorandum dated 19 March 2021 of OIC-CENRO Calamianes Islands, Corn, Palawan and its enclosures regarding the implementation of Executive Order No. 75, Series of 2019, specifically on Busuanga Pasture Reserve (BPR) in Palawan.

Please be informed that the Memorandum dated 06 October 2020 of the OIC, CENRO Coron Calamianes Islands pertaining to the request for guidance and clearance regarding the letter of Municipal Agrarian Reform Program Officer (MARO) Coron, Palawan, for staff/personnel of the CENRO to join in the conduct of final validation, was received by this Office on 25 November 2020 (copy attached) which is beyond the schedule indicated of the said validation on October 7-16, 2020. Also, based on records, on 06 October 2020, the OIC, CENRO Calamianes Islands sent a letter to MARO informing that they cannot join the said validation without clearance from the Director of FMB. Apparently, in the same letter, CENRO Calamianes Islands already informed the MARO to direct their communication to the Bureau regarding the matter. However, this Office has not received any communication to this effect.

Nevertheless, this Office is appalled by the issuance of the Certificate of Land Ownership Awards (CLOA) notwithstanding the on-going protest and the absence of validation. The aforesaid CLOA signed by DAR Secretary John R. Castriciones covers Lot No. 535 and Lot No. 385, CAD 1150-D with an area of 27.5807 and 127.5156 hectares, respectively.

Further, upon review and evaluation of the CLOA with Lot numbers 535 and 385, CAD 1150-D described in the Deed of Transfer of DAR, this Office finds some parts of the area within the >18% slope. Based on the analysis made by this Office, 4.03 and 65.91 hectares of Lot No. 535 and Lot No. 385, CAD 1150-D falls within the >18% slope of BPR which is a forestland (copy of map attached hereto).

It bears stressing that when President Ferdinand Marcos issued PP 1387 s. 1975 for the establishment of a pasture reserve in Busuanga, Palawan, the whole BPR was withdrawn from "sale, settlement or any other form of disposition, exploration or exploitation and reserve as a pasture reserve". Hence, the whole 40,000 hectares of BPR area was reclassified into forestland, including the areas which were formerly classified as agricultural Alienable and Disposable (A&D) land<sup>1</sup>.

It must also be emphasized that PP 1387 was issued during the effectivity of the 1973 Constitution, when the legal classification of lands still includes "grazing lands". Section 10 of Article XIV of the 1973 Constitution<sup>2</sup>. The said land classification was removed in the 1987 Constitution. Grazing or pasture land as a classification was consolidated into forest or timber land<sup>3</sup>.

In view of the foregoing, please be informed that this Office will seek legal advice from the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal, Administration, Human Resources and Legislative Affairs thru the DENR Legal Affairs Service pertaining to the courses of actions to be taken on the CLOA issued within BPR. In the meantime, while waiting for the advice from Legal Affairs Service, please be informed that a BPR Management Office Staff will coordinate with your Office and CENRO Calamianes Islands pertaining to the conduct of fact-finding/investigation on the issuance of CLOA covering Lot No. 535 and Lot No. 385, CAD 1150-D within BPR.

Respectfully forwarded is a Memorandum dated March 19, 2021 of OIC-CENRO Coron, Palawan and its enclosures regarding the implementation of Executive Order No. 75, series of 2019.

In the undated Memorandum of the Undersecretary for Legal, Administration, Human Resources and Legislative Affairs, the FMB and DENR MIMAROPA Region are directed to implement in coordination with DAR the agreements reached during a meeting of DAR and DENR officials held on September 21, 2020, subject to the results of the joint DENR-DAR ground validation.

On October 6, 2020, the CENRO-Coron, Palawan in his Memorandum requested for guidance/clearance on the request of DAR for validation of the eleven (11) cadastral lots. Parallel to this, the BPRMO in its Memorandum on even date also sought guidance/clearance from the Director, FMB. However, the said CENR Office has not received any reply from higher authorities regarding said request.

Relative to this, please be informed that while the protest is on-going and validation is still to be conducted, DAR already issued CLOA in Busuanga within BPR, particularly Lot No. 535, CAD 1150-D situated in Barangay San Rafael, Busuanga, Palawan covering 27.5807 hectares and Lot No. 385, CAD 1150, situated in Barangay Old Busuanga, Busuanga, Palawan covering 127.5156 hectares.

In view of this, since the FMB is the administrator of Busuanga Pasture Reserve per Proclamation 663, series of 2013, may we respectfully refer this matter for legal advise/guidance for our appropriate course of action.
