AN ACT DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALAUAN, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA, A FARM TOURISM DESTINATION, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Municipality of Calauan, Province of Laguna, is hereby declared a

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farm tourism destination. As such, its development shall be prioritized by the Department of 2 Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of farm 3 tourism destinations pursuant to Republic Act No. 10816, otherwise known as the "Farm 4 5 Tourism Development Act of 2016". 6 Sec. 2. Within six (6) months after the approval of this Act, the DOT, in coordination with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and other concerned 7 8 agencies of the government, shall prepare a development plan that shall include the 9 construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure that shall enhance farm tourism in the area: Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the 10 preservation of the natural beauty and resources in the area. 11 12 Sec. 3. The DOT shall take immediate steps to implement the development plan and

incorporate the same in its tourism development program for the ensuing calendar year.

- Sec. 4. The Secretary of the DOT shall include in the Department's program the
- 2 implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
- 3 Appropriations Act, and shall augment such allocation with internally generated funds of the
- 4 Department.
- 5 Sec. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the DOT shall promulgate
- 6 the necessary rules and regulations for the proper implementation of this Act.
- Sec. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
- 8 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
- 9 Approved,
