3	Provide assistance to the Provincial Health of Marinduque with the availability of ultra-low temperature freezers for Pfizer vaccines which requires lower temperatures	DOH MIMAROPA
4	Discuss the possible delegation to the District Superintendents the approval for the utilization of the schools as Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities	DEPED MIMAROPA
5	Issue a Joint Resolution, requesting the Local Government Units of MIMAROPA to issue relevant Executive Orders imposing stiffer penalties for violators of Minimum Health Protocols, and to undertake appropriate legal actions against the said violators, within the boundaries of existing laws	RTF and RIATF MIMAROPA
6	Draft the Joint RTF-RIATF Memorandum for the approval of the respective Task Forces' Member Agencies, imposing stiffer penalties to MHPS violators	OCD MIMAROPA
