Kindly acknowledge receipt of this email.

This is with regards to your unnumbered water permit application/s for appropriation of water in Sitio Caalan, Brgy. Masagana, El Nido, Palawan. Upon initial screening, it appears that the following requirements still need to be submitted including the payment of 7,200 PHP filing fee: 1. Upon checking, the bacteriological test failed the standards. Kindly submit a manifestation letter on how the water will be treated.

2. Kindly provide the actual discharge of the well. This could be measured using a volumetric method. You could also measure how long it takes for 1 tank to be filled up with the valve fully opened

Furthermore, your application is subject to a penalty of P1,000 for drilling a deepwell without permit pursuant to Article 90(j) of P.D. 1067.

You may submit the requirements stated above through this email. However, you will have to send the payment of the filing fee to our office which you may bring to our office personally or through mail (check/cash). No reply to this email within seven (7) days will compel us to return your documents.

If anything is unclear to you, feel free to reply to this email anytime.

We hope you could submit everything as soon as possible so we may process your application right away.
