This has reference to the results of the recently concluded on-line conference relative to the implementation of the Philippine Master Plan for Climate Resilient Forestry Development (PMPCRFD) held on 26 August 2021. This activity was attended by officials and representatives from the central office, bureaus and regional offices to discuss, agree and/or level-off on the following:

1. Harmonization of universe, baselines and targets under the PMPCRFD as a result of the consultations with the Regional Offices;
2. Strategic directions relative to the implementation of PMPCRFD to achieve its targets and objectives; and
3. Draft logical framework for the PMPCRFD, as part of the development Results Based Monitoring and Evaluation.

Relative thereto, the Regional Executive Directors (REDs) are advised to ensure compliance of the Field Offices to the agreements reached thereof, more especially on the following:

1. Finalization of data relative to universe, baselines, targets and accomplishments relative to the implementation of the PMPCRFD. The regional offices are requested to submit on or before **29 October 2021**, a completed matrix showing the updated accomplishments (as of June 2021) and targets (2022-2028) based on the strategic directions discussed during the workshop. To facilitate determination of future targets, activities with no identified universe shall adopt the zero-based targeting scheme.
2. Submission of comments and recommendations/inputs to the draft Logical Framework for the PMPCRFD and proposed additional Unit of Work Measures (UWMs), on or before **01 October 2021**.


IV. Ways Forward

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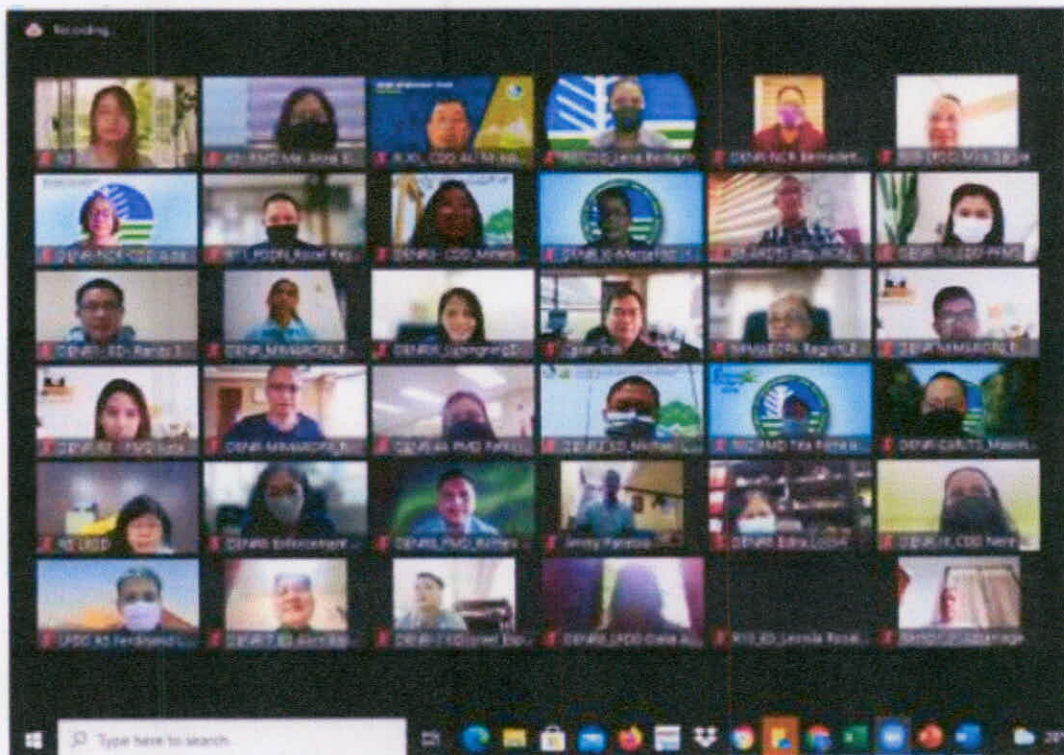
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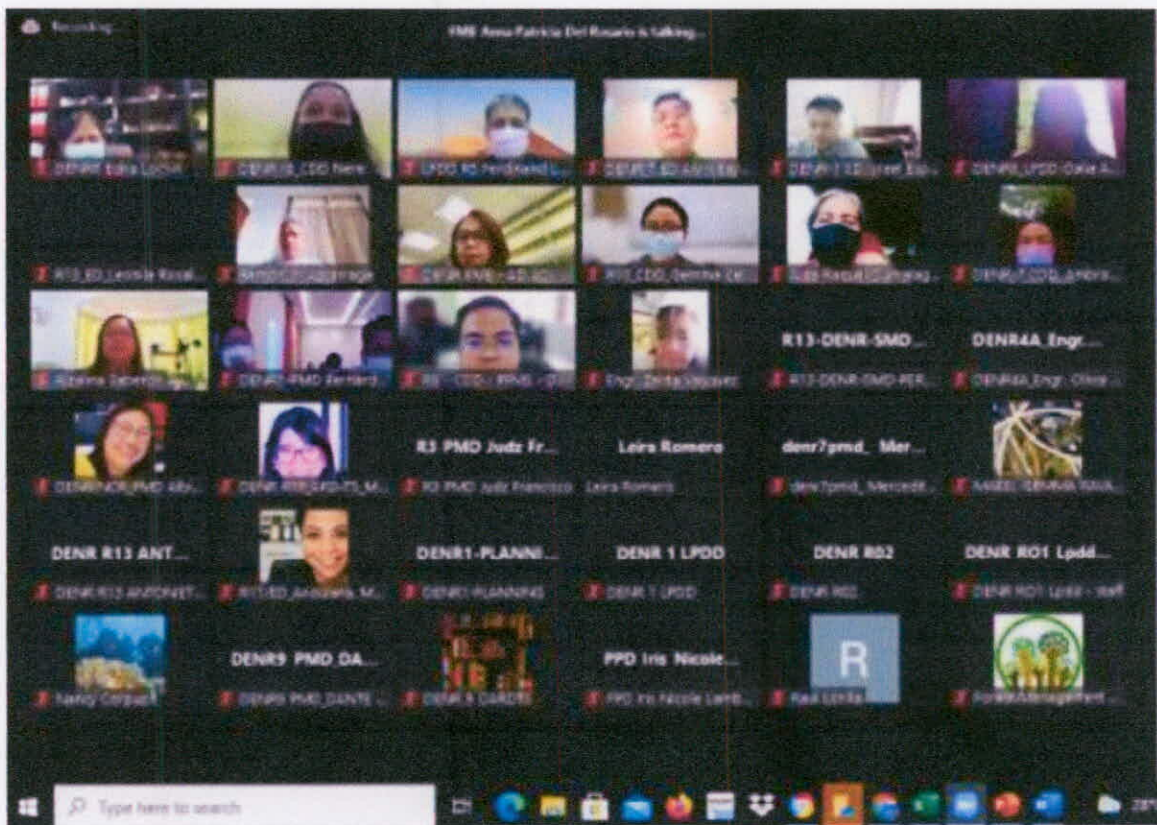
