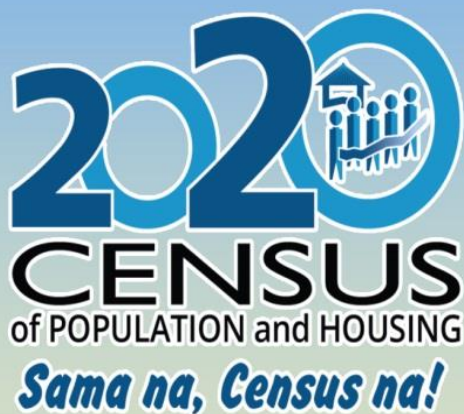




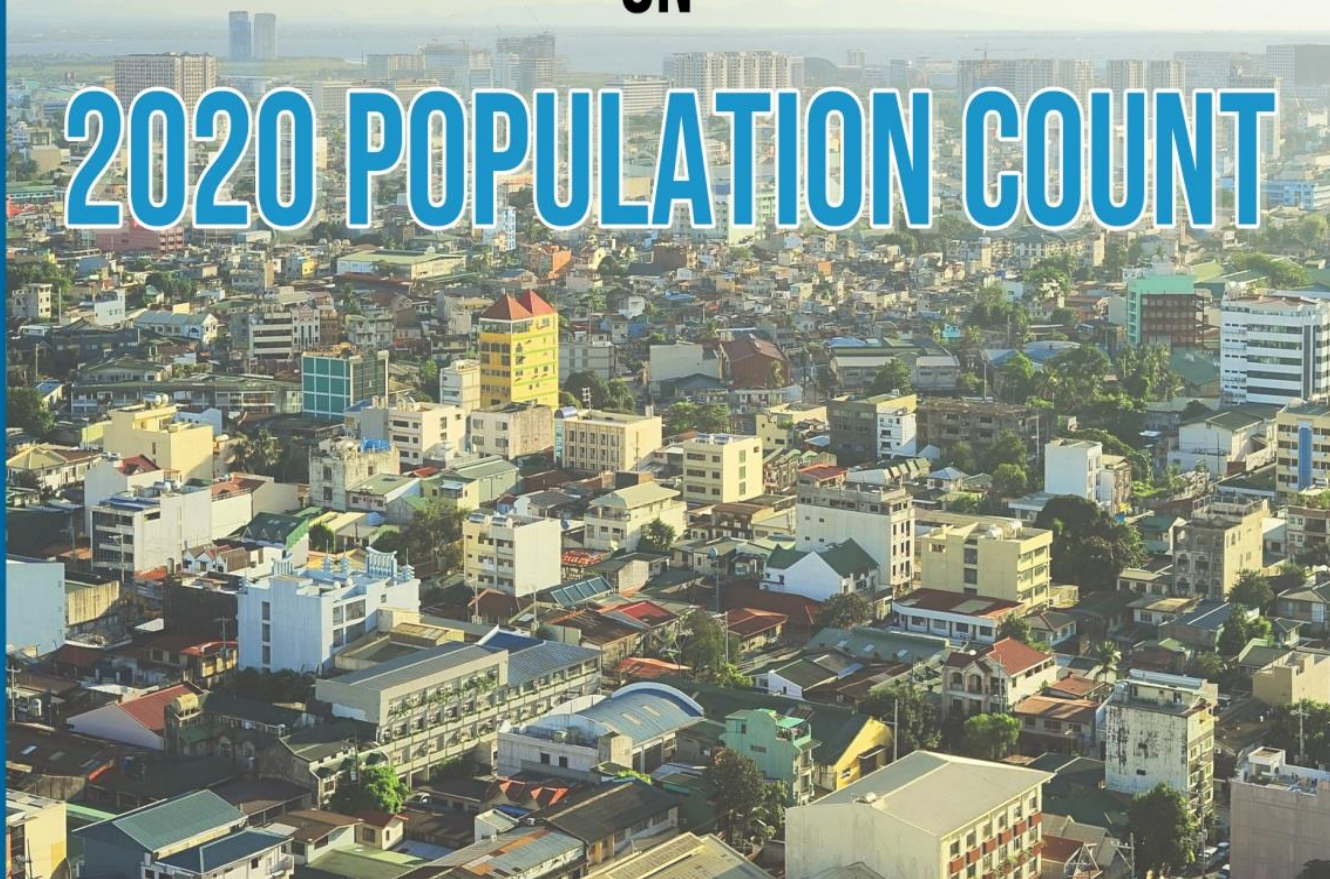

Occidental Mindoro's Total Population in Various Census Years

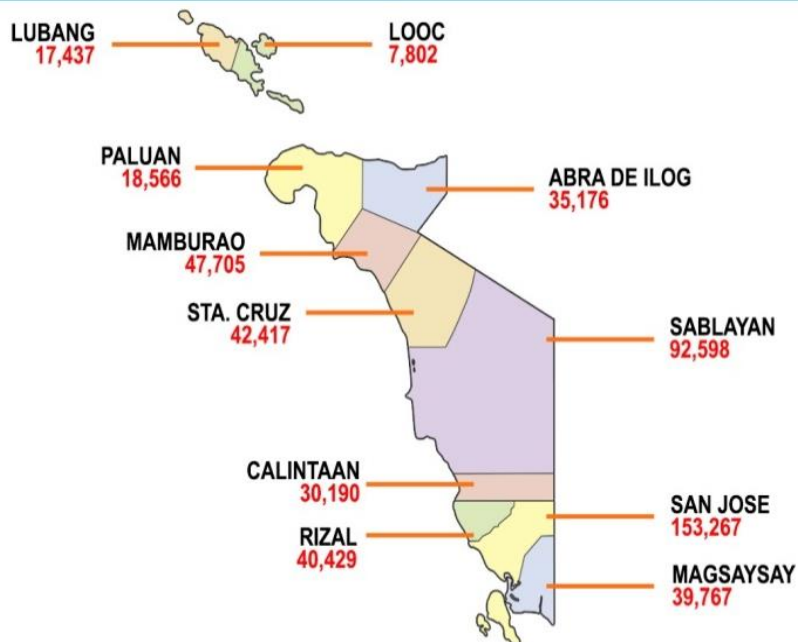

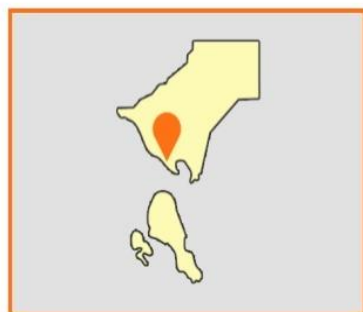

Population by Municipality, Occidental Mindoro: 2020



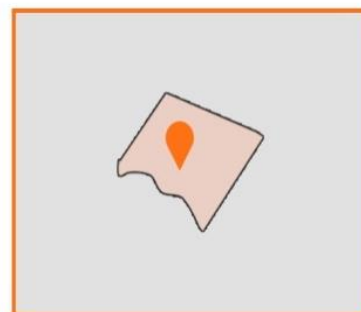
TOP THREE MOST POPULATED BARANGAYS IN OCCIDENTAL MINDORO

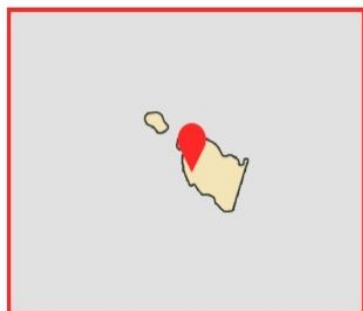

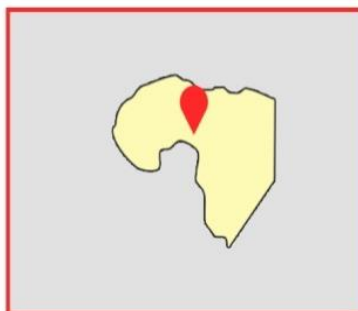
