It has been observed that the estimated market value was not indicated for each incident of apprehension and/or seizure. Moreover, please be reminded to update the status of the administrative adjudication proceedings for each incident of apprehension and/or seizure of undocumented forest products including conveyances, tools and equipment as provided under DAO 97-32.

In addition, please be advised to use simultaneously the e-FMS in recording apprehended/ seized and/or confiscated undocumented forest products and other subsequent actions pursuant to the Memorandum dated 29 June 2021 signed by Assistant Secretary for Enforcement.

Finally, future similar reports on wildlife, e.g. illicit wildlife trade, must be forwarded to the Biodiversity Management Bureau.

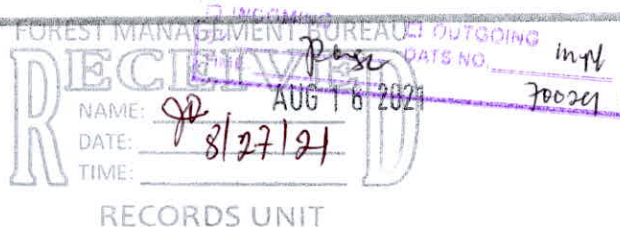

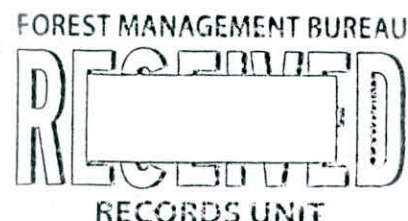

FOR THE MONTH OF JULY 2021**

Respectfully submitted is the apprehension report on illegal logging, wildlife and cases filed for the month of July 2021.

Please be informed that for the month of July 2021, there were a total of 23 apprehensions made in the entire region with most of the reports came from the province of Palawan with a total of 11 apprehensions conducted, in which almost half of the apprehensions were assisted/initiated by the PNP/AFP.

Said apprehensions had a total estimated fair market value of **Php288,368.55** for the forest products alone excluding the market value of the apprehended units of chainsaw and conveyances. A total of 2 units of chainsaw were apprehended from the provinces of Oriental and Palawan. Also, there were two (2) reports of less than 10 sacks of undocumented wood charcoal apprehended in the region.

Below are the matrixes of summary of apprehensions for the month of July 2021 (Table 1), Summary of Apprehended Wood Charcoal (Table 2), and Cases Filed as of July 31, 2021 (Table 3).


