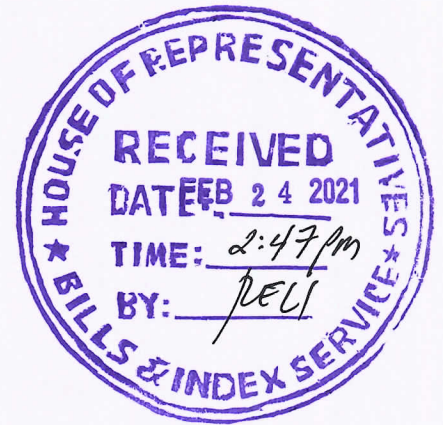


EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to reclassify portions of forest land of public domain located in the heart of Barangay Imulnod, Municipality of Brooke's Point, Province of Palawan.

The parcel of land being applied for reclassification has been identified and used more suitably for agricultural and residential purposes. Members of the locality built their barangay hall and elementary school within the area sought to be reclassified.

The reclassification of this parcel of land will reflect its actual usage and promote further development of the barangay and school site. Moreover, the reclassification of this parcel of land will allow the respective parties to perfect their rights and encourage development of infrastructure in the area.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate approval of this bill is earnestly recommended.

AN ACT
RECLASSIFYING A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND OF PUBLIC DOMAIN
LOCATED IN BARANGAY IMULNOD, MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKE'S
POINT, PROVINCE OF PALAWAN, FROM FOREST LAND TO
ALIENABLE OR DISPOSABLE LAND

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippine Congress Assembled:

Section 1. The herein described parcel of land of public domain located in Barangay Imulnod, Municipality of Brooke's Point, Province of Palawan, containing a total land area Six Hundred Sixty-Eight and Three Thousand Thirty Six Thousandths (668.3686) hectares, more or less, within the jurisdiction of Barangay Imulnod, Municipality Of Brooke's Point, Province Of Palawan, is hereby declared as alienable or disposable land for agricultural, commercial, residential, industrial or other productive purposes.

Said parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

Section 2. Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall promulgate the rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

Section 3. All laws, executive orders, and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in the Official Gazette or two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
