Good day! Forest Foundation Philippines is a non-profit organization that provides grants to organizations that empower the people to protect the forests. Fundamental to the implementation of the Foundation's Results Framework (RF) 2017-2021 is its long-term goal of sustainable management of the forests in its focal landscapes. Part of this strategy is strengthening the collaboration among its partners and stakeholders within the landscape through an annual Partner's Meeting. The Partners' Meeting provides the venue for constructive dialogue, as well as sharing strategic information on sustainable management of forests to ensure coordinated support among partners.

This year's Partners Meeting for the Palawan Landscape is anchored on the theme "Growing Futures: Sustainable Landscapes, Empowered Communities", to acknowledge the past accomplishments, current success and challenges, and the need to think through multiple possibilities of what the future holds for forest conservation work to enable a more concrete, strategic, and concerted actions moving forward.

The Meeting, which will be held via the Zoom platform on 26-27 April, 2021 (Zoom link to be sent later), is co-hosted by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS), the professional support staff of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development. PCSD is a multi-sectoral and inter-disciplinary body in charge of the governance, implementation, and policy direction of the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act (Republic Act 7611). In light of the closing of Foundation's RF 2017-2021 and planning for the next five-year strategy plan; and in accordance with PCSD's mandate and role as the primary agency for sustainable development and management of natural resources in Palawan, this part aims to bring together different stakeholders and decision-makers in the Palawan landscape and provide a platform for knowledge-sharing (e.g., programs, plans, initiatives) and opportunities for multi-stakeholder collaboration.

In line with this, we would like to invite you as a resource speaker for Session 1: Mandated Agencies' Landscape-level Plans and Programs related to forests, agroforestry,
