1. MANDATORY PCR TEST FOR ALL INBOUND TRAVELERS TO DOHA

Effective <u>Sunday, 25 April 2021</u>, Qatar Ministry of Public Health has mandated implementation of the below travel policy:

All inbound/returning travelers to Qatar, including those previously vaccinated or previously infected, must present a COVID-19 PCR test within <u>72 hours</u> of arrival in Qatar at the country of origin in a medical center that their local ministry of health approved to offer/operate to do the PCR test for COVID-19.

The PCR test result should be negative before they are allowed to board the aircraft to Qatar or enter Qatar through any ports of entry (HIA/Abu Samra land border/ seaport).

Kindly note that above travel requirement does not apply to transiting passengers in DOH. For transiting passengers kindly refer to the travel requirements of country of final destination.

2. MANILA TO CALBAYOG V.V. SERVICE RESUMES ON MAY 5

Philippine Airlines is all set to resume weekly services between Manila and Calbayog (Samar Province, Eastern Visayas) starting May 5.

... while PR2672 leaves Calbayog at 11AM and touches down in Manila at 12:35PM.

Fights to/from Calbayog will operates twice weekly -- every Thursday and Sunday -- beginning July 4 and will shift to thrice weekly -- Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday - by October 5.



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At present, flights between Manila and Calbayog are for Locally-Stranded Individuals (LSIs), Returning Oveseas Filipinos (ROFs), Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR).

Travelers arriving in Calbayog from Manila must present a negative RT-PCR Test Result (taken within 72 hours prior to the entry) and are not required to undergo quarantine unless they exhibit symptoms of covid.

Certificate of Coordination or Acceptance shall still be issued to travelers who may need it as a requirement from their point of origin. All inbound travelers are required to pass through the triage unit of the OPCEN in Sitio Talahib, Brgy. Trinidad, for screening upon arrival to the city. PAL is strictly implementing "new normal" health and safety protocols, in coordination with local government units. 3. PAL FLIGHTS TO/FROM ZAMBOANGA

We are pleased to advise that PAL is adding a Sunday flight from Manila to Zamboanga starting April 25, 2021.

The 3x weekly Manila to Zamboanga flights operates every Monday, Thursday and Sunday. Our passengers have plenty of flights to choose from for Zamboanga to Manila with the 6x weekly flights.

Philippine Airlines also flies to Tawi-tawi and Cebu from Zamboanga every Monday. These once weekly flights will utilize Airbus A320 starting May 3, 2021.

Note: We may have to cancel flights, add frequencies or adjust our planned schedules, based on evolving quarantine restrictions and entry requirements set by the Philippine authorities and local government units (LGUs).

4. ADVISORY ON SUSPENSION OF PASSENGER MOVEMENT INBOUND UAE FROM INDIA

Effective **24 April 2021**, operation of all air services and/or inbound passenger movement to UAE from any point in the **Republic of India** is suspended. This will take effect for a period of ten **(10) days**, and may be extended for a further period if necessity arises.

This decision does not apply to the members of the diplomatic missions, UAE nationals and those passengers exempted and/or granted permission to enter UAE by the appropriate authorities.

Those exempted as stated shall on and after arrival shall comply with the following:

- a. all inbound passengers shall be guarantined for ten (10) days from the date of arrival.
- b. PCR tests has to be carried out upon arrival at the airport and on 4th and 8th day from the date of arrival
- c. Ensure that every inbound passenger is holding a VALID Covid-19 Test certificate that is issued within the valid time frame, namely, 48 hours from the time of collecting the sample and scheduled flight departure. Also ensure that the time of sample collection "Date & Time" and time of reporting "Result date and Result time" are accurate.
- d. The PCR test reports shall be accepted only from a certified lab which use QR code.

In addition, please be advised that, this decision does not apply to freighter (cargo) operation, business flights and the outbound passengers from UAE.

Airlines and/or private operators shall NOT accept any passenger(s) on board, if such passenger has travelled to and/or visited the Republic of India within fourteen (14) days prior to the entry in to the UAE and whose final destination is Dubai or in transit through Dubai, except for UAE Nationals who are returning to UAE.

5. PAL TRAVEL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS
