WORKSHOP ON PRIVATE SECTOR FUND-RAISING

The Biodiversity Management Bureau in collaboration with the United Nations Development Programme through the Biodiversity Finance Initiative Project (UNDP-BIOFIN) is pleased to invite you to the Online Capacity Building Workshop on Private Sector Fund-Raising to be held on **16-18 June 2021.**

The Protected Area Finance Plan (PAFP) Training Program in December 2020 and the Coaching and Mentoring Workshop in May 2021 revealed the potential for mobilizing resources to support the preparation and implementation of the Protected Area Management Plans (PAMPs). Participants have been able to identify different finance solution schemes that may be developed and implemented in the identified protected areas. One of the finance solutions that is being explored is engaging the private sector, particularly unlocking corporate social responsibility for biodiversity conservation. The Capacity Building Workshop on Private Sector Fund-Raising will build on this Training Program and the PAFPs that have been generated.

The Capacity Building Workshop is designed for three (3) session-days and will be held online via Zoom. Detailed design of the Workshop is attached for your reference. It will be composed of the following modules:

- 1. Fund-Raising and Partnerships with the Private Sector
- 2. Fund-Raising Programs Planning
- 3. Public and Private Partnership Conversations on Biodiversity
- 4. Pitch Preparation

The Capacity Building Workshop will be participated in by the Chiefs or representatives of the Region's Conservation and Development Division (CDD), concerned PENRO Planning Officers, Protected Area Superintendents of the selected PAs, technical staff of the selected PA Management Offices, and PAMB member from the Sustainable Financing Committee or equivalent Committee of the selected PAs.



We have attached a copy of the draft DENR Special Order and the Program of Activities for reference. Our staff from the UNDP-Biofin and National Parks Division will be coordinating with you on the details of this activity.
