



Relative to the approved Work and Financial Plan for CY 2020, under the operations against illegal environment and natural resources activities, please be informed that this Office conducted a joint virtual meeting of Regional Multi-Sectoral Forest Protection Committee (RMFPC) and Regional Anti-Illegal Logging Task Force (RAILTF) on October 27, 2020 via Zoom application.

The meeting was attended by representatives from member agencies such as: Police Regional Office (PRO), Philippine Army (PA), Philippine Air Force (PAF), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Office of the Provincial Prosecutor in Palawan, DILG, DA, and DPWH MIMAROPA and representative from DENR-MGB MIMAROPA.

The meeting started with the opening program followed within a welcome message delivered by ARD for Technical Services Vicente B. Tuddao Jr., *Ph.* which he recognized the active participation of the members of the committee especially in suppressing the violators of ENR laws, rules, and regulations within MIMAROPA Region. He also stressed that there are still reported illegal cutting of timber despite the joint effort of the enforcers. Thus, he called the attention of the committee members to continue working hand in hand with the DENR to avoid/prevent said illegal activities. Thereafter, ARD Vicente Tuddao, presided the meeting. The members adopted the previous minutes of the RMFPC meeting as well as the proposed agenda for the joint meeting.

The Presiding Officer immediately proceeded with the first agenda: the presentation of DENR MIMAROPA on Apprehension Accomplishment Report on apprehension of illegal forest products, conveyances, and implements covering January 2020- September 30, 2020 as well as the accomplishment report of LAWIN patrollers. A presentation regarding the operational accomplishment against illegal environmental activities was presented by the Philippine Army. On the hand, the Philippine Coast Guard reported their clean up drive activities, tree planting of mangrove species and other similar ENR activities. However, due to technical connectivity issues caused by Typhoon Quinta, the Police Regional Office of MIMAROPA was not able to present their operational accomplishment report.



Opening remarks/address was delivered by Assistant Regional Director for Technical Services Vicente B. Tuddao, Jr. ARD Tuddao recognized the active participation of the members of the committee especially in suppressing the violations of ENR laws, rules and regulations within MIMAROPA Region.

Assistant Regional Director also stressed that there were still reported illegal cutting of timber despite of the joint effort of enforcers, thus, he calls the attention of the committee members to work hand in hand with the DENR to avoid/prevent said illegal activities.

The participants were then introduced by Mr. Lino M. Dimapilis, Chief, Enforcement Division.

55 PCG: Motion for the approval of the agenda of the joint meeting and the minutes of the
56 previous meeting (last August 21, 2019) was raised. Moved for the adoption of the minutes of

59 MGB-MIMAROPA (Atty. Kirby Sagauinit): Seconded the motion raised.

61 ARD TUDDAO: Lets first proceed to line no. 114 of the minutes of the previous meeting
62 regarding the composition of the committees pertaining to the livelihood programs to be
63 chaired by Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD).

65 ARD TUDDAO: Then line no. 125 of the minutes of the previous meeting regarding the IEC
66 activities to be headed by the Department of Education (DEPED).
67
68 ARD TUDDAO: Division Chief Lino Dimapilis, I want the status of lines 114 and 125 to be
69 presented in the next RMFPC/RAILTF meeting.

71 FOR. MARGIE U. OCHOA, (DENR-MIMAROPA Regional Office): A Memorandum of
72 Agreement (MOA) was already drafted and sent to the concerned agencies for review and
73 approval.

75 ARD TUDDAO: Matagal na iyan, naka-three (3) revisions na. Next meeting, kindly present
76 the final copy of the MOA, for affirmation/signing.

78 ARD TUDDAO: Lets proceed to page five (5) of the minutes, line no. 185, on the matter
79 raised by Atty. Gandhi Flores, Chief Legal Division, DENR-MIMAROPA, on the conduct of
80 workshop with the prosecutor for the harmonization of ENR laws and procedures.

82 PROSECUTOR CAABAY, (Palawan Prosecutors Office): Sir, I attended the previous
83 RMFPC/RAILTF meeting last year (August 21, 2019). Said matter was already addressed
84 during the conduct of the online workshop via zoom, on case filing last October 21-23, 2020.
85
86 LINO M. DIMAPILIS (Chief, Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region: The
87 issue on the release of conveyance is a grey area between the DOJ (Prosecutors) and the
88 DENR.
89
90 ARD TUDDAO: I suggest that another webinar, this time with the members of the
91 committee in relation to the filing of environmental cases should be conducted.
92

93 ARD TUDDAO: Please coordinate with the Chairman of the IEC committee, DEPED, for the
94 conduct of the webinar on the filing of environmental cases.

96 LINO M. DIMAPILIS (Chief, Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region): May I
97 suggest, the topic, rules on procedure on environmental cases.

99 OTHER TOPICS DISCUSSED: PRESENTATION OF DENR ACCOMPLISHMENT
100 REPORT FROM JANUARY TO SEPTEMBER 2020, PRESENTED BY MR. ARNEL N.
101 ASTRERA, STAFF, ENFORCEMENT DIVISION, DENR-MIMAROPA REGION.

103 ARD TUDDAO: (after the presentation) Commended the presentation for being comparative
104 (2019-2020). However, next time, dapat per province ang presentation.

106 LINO M. DIMAPILIS (Chief, Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region): Diba
107 Arnel may report din tayo sa LAWIN?

109 ARD TUDDAO: Every presentation, proceed to open forum.

111 ARD TUDDAO: Based on the presentation, there are more violations in 2019 as compared to
112 2020, lower number of violations, but higher cases filed and conviction. What do you think is
113 the reason behind this?

115 LINO M. DIMAPILIS (Chief, Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region):
116 Because of the presence of pandemic. Also, LAWIN patrolling activities, the presence of
117 LAWIN patrollers is one of the reasons for the lesser number of violators.

119 ARD TUDDAO: Lets compare later our data to that of the PNP and Coast Guard after their
120 presentation.

122 ARD TUDDAO: Next time, lets come with a deeper analysis. Correlation analysis,
123 considering the various factors that may affect our enforcement activities.

125 ARD TUDDAO: Next presentation please.

127 ARNEL N. ASTRERA (Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region): I will present
128 the LAWIN Forest and Biodiversity Protection System, which pertains to a system used by
129 forest rangers and forest protection officers for their patrolling within their respective areas of
130 jurisdiction. I will present a short video regarding the LAWIN activities to enlighten the
131 members of the committee.

133 For the information of the body, DENR-MIMAROPA ranks first (national ranking) as
134 regards to responses in addressing the different environmental threats. The region ranks
135 fourth in terms of the total areas patrolled nationwide.

137 ARD TUDDAO: The LAWIN patrol mechanism of the DENR plays a vital role in the
138 enforcement of ENR laws, rules and regulations. The DENR needs the full back-up support

of the members of the committee, especially the PNP and AFP to maintain and pursue its purpose.

ARNEL N. ASTRERA (Enforcement Division, DENR-MIMAROPA Region), inform the committee that the LAWIN System reflects route of the patrollers, and recorded any observations within the conservation areas such as cutting, garbage disposal, kaingin, and other activities in the said area.

ARD TUDDAO: Again, we seek the support of the PNP and AFP in the conduct of this activity, like in the hot spot areas in Palawan, particularly in Brooke's Point and Taytay.

COL. REYNOLD R. RUECA (Philippine Air Force): For the information of the body, there was a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) executed between the DENR (National) and PAF in 2013, in relation to the conduct of aerial survey. There is still a remaining fourteen (14) million pesos budget (downloaded to PAF) to be utilize in the said activity.

DENR field Offices should first coordinate with the PAF, and send their request. There are two (2) tactical operations wing. The first wing covers the area of MIMARO (Southern Luzon), and the second wing covers PALAWAN (Western Luzon).

As regards to the availability of aircraft, the conduct of aerial survey should be first coordinated with the PAF ten (10) days prior to the actual flight. The aerial survey will be a big help in monitoring the different NGP sites and the hot spot areas in the region.

BRIG. GEN. GERNALE (WESTERN COMMAND): At present, there are no available asset (aircrafts) available, but we can forward your request in the National Headquarters.

SECOND AGENDA:

PHILIPINE COAST GUARD: Presented their accomplishment report from January to September 2020. The presentation centered in their coastal clean-up activities, mangrove and tree planting activities in Palawan, which covers a total area of 41 km.

PHILIPPINE COAST GUARD: Pinaka-minomonitor naming yung sa mangrove areas, particularly sa Ihawig area.

ARD TUDDAO: Can we have the total area planted? Andito po ang NGP coordinator namin, para po macoordinate. We acknowledge the efforts of the PCG, and hope to sustain our partnership.

REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE PNP-MIMAROPA REGIONAL OFFICE WAS NOT ABLE TO ATTEND THE ZOOM MEETING DUE TO SIGNAL INTERRUPTION CAUSED BY TYPHOON QUINTA. NEVERTHELESS, THEIR ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT FROM JANUARY TO SEPTEMBER 2020 WAS PRESENTED BY THE CHIEF, ENFORCEMENT DIVISION LINO DIMAPILIS IN BEHALF OF PRO MIMAROPA
