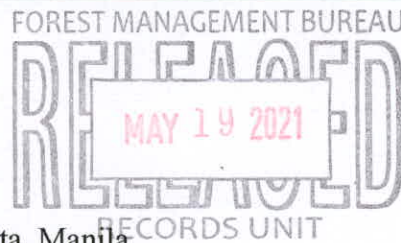

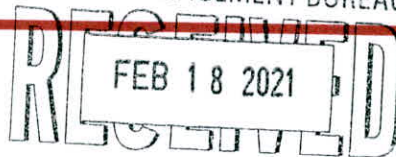

On the 1st Quarter of CY 2020, mortality was observed on some commodities planted such as cacao and bamboos due to El Niño phenomenon in 2019. On the 2nd Quarter, the Board of Directors (BOD) conducted a meeting to formulate a catch-up plan to replant the damaged commodities. The replanting activities were conducted on the 3rd Quarter during the rainy season (June to October 2020). The table below shows the result of the monitoring activity conducted on the 4th Quarter:
