SUBJECT: SUCBEM CLUSTER LEVELING MEETING

DATE : MARCH 09, 2021

BACKGROUND

In line with the efforts to end local communist armed conflict, OIC Undersecretary for Local Government Marlo L. Iringan called for a National Leveling Session of the Sectoral Unification, Capacity Building, Empowerment, and Mobilization (SUCBEM) Cluster.

The activity aimed to:

- Present the current status of the national cluster in terms of 2020 significant activities, issues and concerns, and 2021 ways forward;
- 2. Present and review the cluster main thesis (implementation plan, general and specific objectives, operation flow, etc.) and if it is aligned with the current cluster main thesis direction;
- level-off with each seventeen (17) Joint Regional Task Forces Cluster and completing the filling-up of personnel for each cluster;
- Educate the additional new member of the JRTFs Technical Working Group (TWG), JRTFs Operation Centers (OpCen), and JRTFs cluster members; and,
- Determine the key Result Areas (KRAs) and Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) of each of the specific objectives of each cluster.

Hence, this memo brief.







DATE, VENUE, AND PARTICIPANTS

The activity was conducted online through Zoom on March 8, 2021. It was participated by the different member agencies of the SUCBEM Cluster in all 17 regions.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Discussion of CTGs Mass Base Building from the National Strategic Research Group. The Echelon of Alliances was emphasized. This pertains to the sectoral unification and classification and the principles as the class basis for waging the national democratic revolution.
- The SUCBEM Objectives and Implementation Plan were discussed by Mr. Zaldy Masangcay while NAPC HEA Elias Labro, Jr. discussed the SUCBEM National Performance Report. Proposed targets and indicators were also presented
- Presentation of Regional SUCBEM Cluster Accomplishments. Each cluster representative presented the Regional SUCBEM cluster accomplishment for FY 2020 vis-a-vis the SUCBEM objectives and also discussed the Ways Forward for FY 2021.
- Sec. Allan Capuyan of NCIP discussed the main thesis of SUCBEM.
 In his message, he emphasized that among the 12 clusters of
 ELCAC, SUCBEM is the expression of our victory among CTGs
 because it aims to unify the government and the society. Further, he
 also emphasized that one of the responsibilities of SUCBEM is to fix
 and organize the sectors on the field.
- Usec. Marlo Iringan of DILG provided the closing message of the activity. In his message, he emphasized that all members of each regional cluster should ensure convergence and help each other to attain the desired results and objectives. He also expressed his desire to conduct more conversations with regional counterparts to harmonize common efforts to end local communist conflicts.

The NTF will send the list based on PSA Listahanan 2020 of the 40 poorest provinces, 400 poorest cities/ municipalities, 4000 poorest barangays plus 882 BDP barangays to the desk officers for distribution to regional cluster members. This will serve as the guide in mapping the prioritization areas.
From BFAR: Can we be provided the list of communities who have completed the RCSP? This will help us to target the right communities for our PPAs	The National Task Force will provide the copy or list of Barangays covered by RCSP for 2020 and 2021. BFAR will give their personal contact details to EO 70 PMO
From BFAR: When can we receive the guidelines and mechanics for the conduct of Regional Planning?	The National Task Force is still in the process of finalizing the said document and for consultation with other agencies.
From BFAR and DAR: Only a few DILG Regions mentioned the interventions of BFAR and DAR in the implementation of SUCBEM.	This should be noted by the members of JRTFs as the accomplishment should highlight the collaboration and convergence in each region. All members of the clusters should participate and share their accomplishments in the implementation of SUCBEM programs and projects.

- Identification of Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for the Cluster. There must be a leveling off to come up with appropriate indicators and identify specific objectives per sector of society.









