Mindoro Biodiversity Conservation Foundation Inc. (MBCFI) is a non-stock, non-profit organization which focuses on the conservation of environment, biodiversity and natural resources in

For the past few years, MBCFI has been involved in the conservation of the critically endangered Tamaraw (*Bubalus mindorensis*). One of our involvements include a partnership with CFI Oliver Philippine Champion Award 2019 with a proposed study entitled Dietary Analysis of Tamaraw (*Bubalus mindorensis*) in Mindoro Island, Philippines. This study will be conducted in (MIBNP), Mindoro Occidental and Mt. Gimparay, Mindoro Oriental.

In addition, a biophysical profile survey will also be conducted in Mt. Gimparay to provide a comprehensive species lists and biodiversity data of the site to support conservation efforts in the site which will serve as baseline for comparison with subsequent monitoring surveys and establish biodiversity monitoring plots for subsequent regular monitoring surveys.

MBCFI was granted with a Gratuitous Permit (GP) from your office last year to conduct the collection of specimens for the study. However, surveys were not conducted in 2020 due to the expiring on the 8th of July this 2021, we are hoping that we will be able to conduct the survey in the 4th quarter of this year. With that, we kindly request for an extension on our GP which will allow us to collect flora samples in both MIBNP and Mt. Gimparay for the dietary analysis (1), and the collection fauna (birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and insects) and flora in Mt. Gimparay for the
